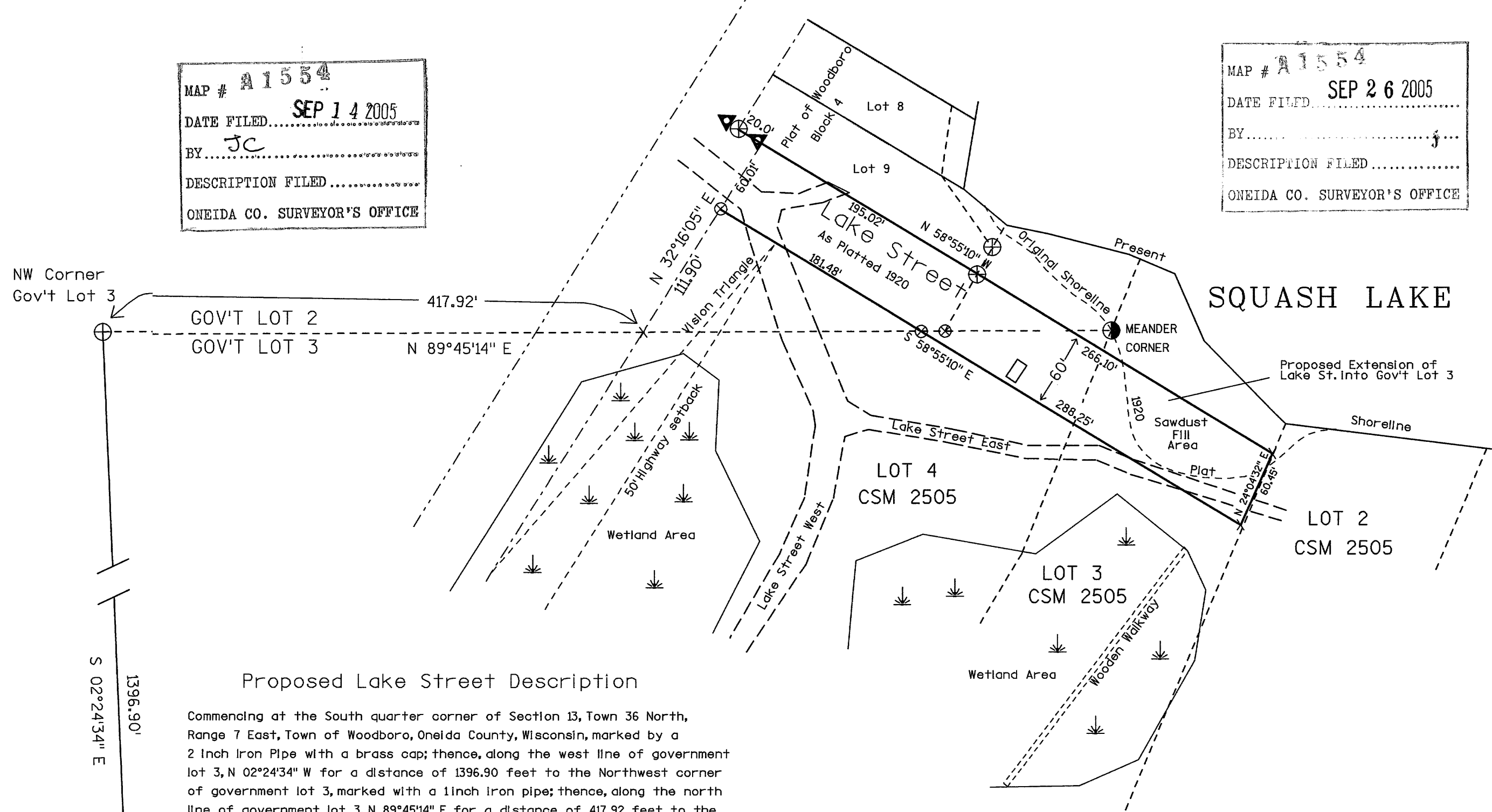


A PARCEL OF LAND, KNOWN AS LAKE STREET, LOCATED

 TOWN OF WOODBORO, ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN

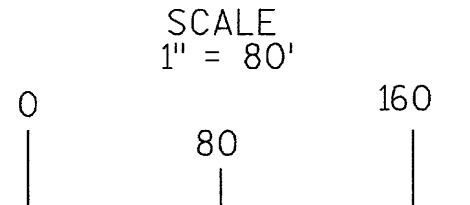

Proposed Lake Street Description

Commencing at the South quarter corner of Section 13, Town 36 North, Range 7 East, Town of Woodboro, Oneida County, Wisconsin, marked by a 2 inch Iron Pipe with a brass cap; thence, along the west line of government lot 3, N 02°24'34" W for a distance of 1396.90 feet to the Northwest corner of government lot 3, marked with a 1 inch iron pipe; thence, along the north line of government lot 3, N 89°45'14" E for a distance of 417.92 feet to the southeasterly line of USH 8 and the northwesterly line of Lot 4, CSM 2505 of Oneida County records; thence, along the northwesterly line of said Lot 4, N 32°16'05" E for a distance of 111.90 feet to the northwest corner of said lot 4, marked with a 3/4 inch Iron rod and the POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence, along the southwesterly line of Lake Street, as shown on said CSM 2505 S 58°55'10" E for a distance of 181.48 feet to a 3/4 inch Iron rod; thence, continuing S 58°55'10" E for a distance of 288.25 feet; thence N 24°04'32" E for a distance of 60.45 feet; thence N 58°55'10" W for a distance of 266.10 feet to a 1 inch Iron pipe; thence, continuing N 58°55'10" W for a distance of 195.02 feet to the southeasterly line of USH 8, marked with a steel post; thence, along the southeasterly line of USH 8, S 32°16'05" W for a distance of 60.01 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING

Containing approximately 0.64 acres.
