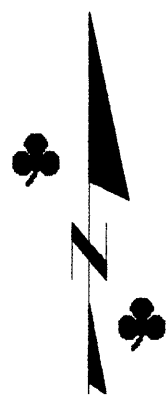

**DESCRIPTION**

Part of Government Lot 1, Section 24, Township 38 North, Range 5 East, town of Minocqua, Oneida County, Wisconsin shown on a survey map by McMullen & Associates, Incorporated of Minocqua, Wisconsin dated the 1st Day of October, 2007, with a Job No. of 207077, previously recorded in Document No. 589469 and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the North 1/4 Corner of said Section marked by a Brass Capped Iron Pipe; thence South 76° 53' 28" East (Assumed North, based on the Westerly line of the parcel described herein which bears North 1° 28' 23" West), a distance of 1578.85 feet to a 1" Iron Pipe on the Southerly right-of-way of West Fork Road, said point being the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Thence North 74° 52' 10" East along said right-of-way, a distance of 102.92 feet to a 1" Iron Pipe; thence leaving said right-of-way South 1° 28' 28" East, a distance of 810.12 feet to a 1" Iron Pipe near the Northern shore of Bear Lake; thence meandering along said lake shore North 87° 45' 46" West, a distance of 100.24 feet to a 1" Iron Pipe; thence leaving said lake shore North 1° 28' 23" West, a distance of 779.33 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Including all those lands lying between the above described meander line and the water's edge of Bear Lake.  
 Subject to any easements, restrictions, or rights of record or of use.
