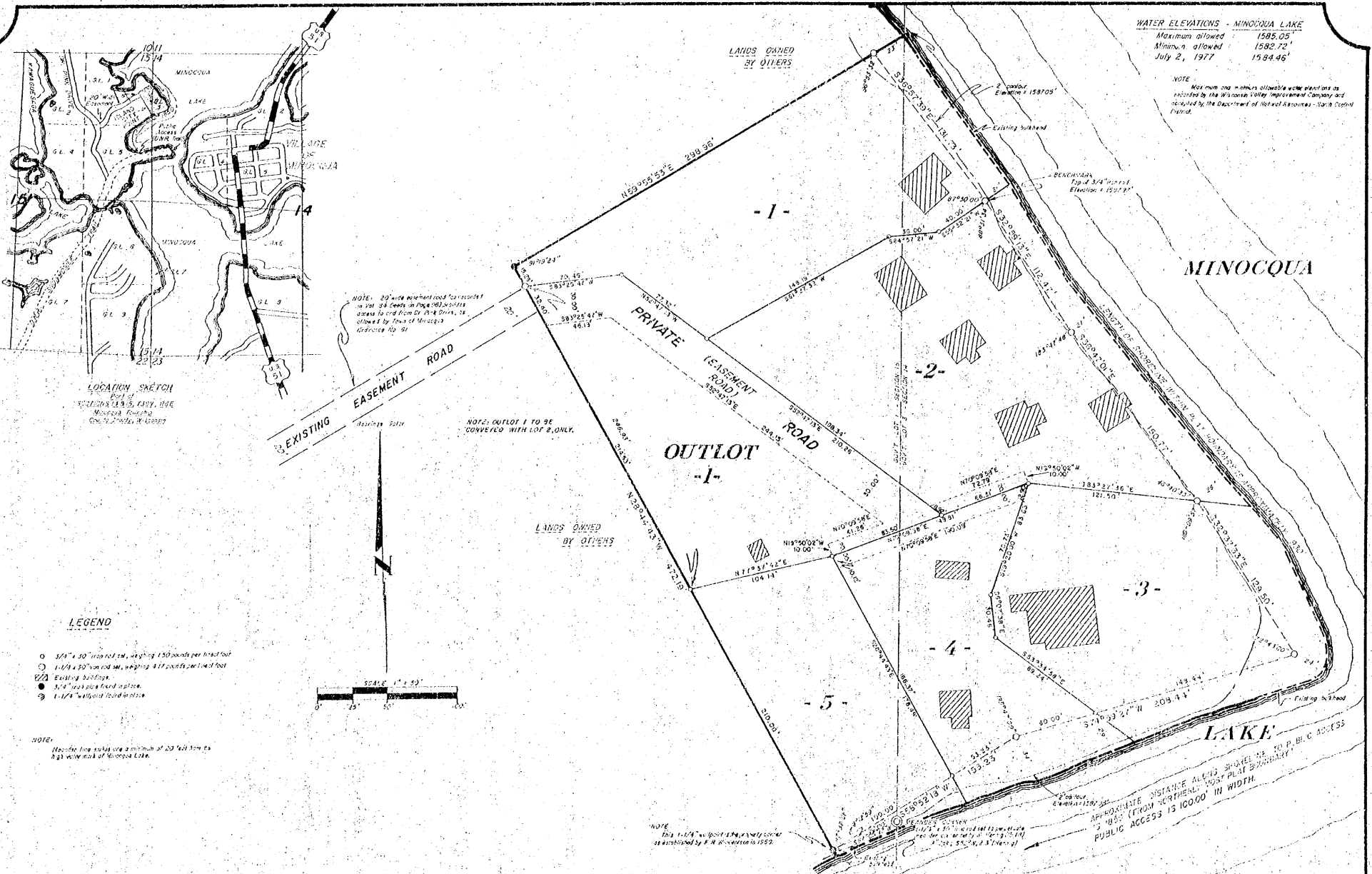

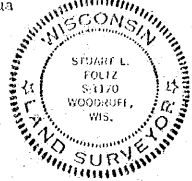
SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE
I, Stuart L. Foltz, Registered Land Surveyor No. S-1170, hereby certify: that in full compliance with the provisions of Chapter 236 of the Wisconsin Statutes and the subdivision regulations of the town of Minocqua, and under the direction of Richard G. Petruskas, I have surveyed, divided and mapped Island City Point, that such plat correctly represents all exterior boundaries and the subdivision of the land surveyed: Being a parcel of land in Gov't Lot 3, Section 14 and in Gov't Lot 1, Section 15, T39N, R6E, Minocqua Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the southerlymost meander corner on the line common to Gov't Lot 3, Section 14 and Gov't Lot 1, Section 15, marked by a 1 1/2" iron rod near the shore of Minocqua Lake, witnessed by a 9" oak, bearing S32°W, 2.3 feet; thence S67°05'12"W, (solar bearing) 50.00 feet to the place of beginning, marked by a 1 1/2" wellpoint.

Thence N28°44'13"W, 472.19 feet to a 3/4" iron pipe; thence N59°55'33"E, 233.96 feet to a 1 1/2" iron rod near the westerly shore of Minocqua Lake; thence meandering along the lake S36°57'39"E, 131.73 feet to a 1 1/2" iron rod; S2°59'13"E, 112.47 feet to a 1 1/2" iron rod; S36°47'01"E, 150.77 feet to a 1 1/2" iron rod; S32°32'13"W, 129.50 feet to a 1 1/2" iron rod; S74°39'27"W, 208.04 feet to a 1 1/2" iron rod; and S58°52'18"W, 153.23 feet to the place of beginning.

Including also all lands lying between the meander lines and the shore of Minocqua Lake.
