

This plat represents a retracement and reestablishment of the boundaries of sec. 31, designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of public lands which were erroneously omitted from the original survey and not shown upon the plat approved February 4, 1860.

The position of the original record meander courses of Planting Ground and Range Line Lakes is shown by irregular lines with numbered angle points. These lines, as thus originally reported, were grossly in error and, with the exception of certain courses fronting on lots, 1, 6, and 8, have been marked as fixed boundaries, with the directions and lengths of the several courses adjusted to the record of the original survey.

Lot 11 has been subdivided in conformity with the areas claimed and occupied, as shown on the

insert diagram.
