SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

We hereby certify that we have surveyed a parcel of land in Govt Lot 5 & 6, Section 25, T. 37 N., R. 8 E., of the 4th PM, Oneida County, Wisconsin and more particularly (described as follows) -

Beginning at the S. 1/4 cor. of Sec. 25 (an iron pipe) on the N. 1/4 line of Sec. 25 (an iron pipe) distant 112.3 ft. on the East shore of the Wisconsin River Flowage 112.3 ft. S. 88° 53' W. of the South 1/4 cor. (an iron pipe) post from which a Black Oak tree 12" in dia. bears S. 75° 40' W. 125.8 ft. distant and a bl. Pine tree 13" in dia. bears S. 25° 40' W. 125.8 ft. distant thence N. 88° 51' E. on 1/4 line 31.3 ft. to an iron pipe thence N. 33° 28' E. 200 ft. to an iron pipe; thence N. 31° 20' E. 75 ft. to an iron pipe; thence N. 3° 15' E. on the N. 1/4 line Sec. 25 151.5 ft. to an iron pipe; thence continue on 1/4 line 117 ft. to an iron pipe; thence continue on 1/4 line 57.4 ft. to the N.C. (an iron pipe from which an Oak tree 12" in dia. bears N. 20° E. 11.1 ft. distant) on the North shore of a small bay of the Wisconsin River Flowage.

Beginning at the 1/4 cor. center of Sec. 25 (an iron pipe) running the N.E. cor. of Govt Lot 6 and the S.E. cor. of Govt Lot 5, thence N. 3° 15' E. on 1/4 line 425.6 ft. to the N.C. on the S. shore of the Wisconsin River Flowage (an iron pipe) from which a bl. Pine 12" in dia. bears S. 27° 14' 22.6" distant and an Oak 12" in dia. bears S. 75° W. 17.3 ft. distant thence N. 32° 23' W. 69 ft.; thence N. 87° 03' W. 49 ft.; thence S. 15° 50' W. 101.4 ft.; thence N. 52° 20' W. 144.7 ft. to an iron pipe from which a bl. Pine 10" in dia. bears N. 16° W. 5 ft. distant; thence S. 80° 53' W. 132.9 ft. to an iron pipe on the East shore of the Wisconsin River Flowage and from which a bl. Pine 12" in dia. bears N. 56° W. 3.6 ft. distant; thence S. 0° 51' E. 174.3 ft.; thence S. 23° 40' E. 142 ft.; thence S. 22° 32' W. 51 ft.; thence N. 70° 54' W. 41 ft.; thence N. 34° 30' W. 119 ft.; thence S. 14° 18' N. 49.3 ft.; thence S. 27° 35' E. 35.5 ft.; thence S. 3° 52' W. 28.5 ft.; thence S. 2° 07' 37.3 ft.; thence S. 2° 00' 123.2 ft.; thence S. 78° 25' E. 21 ft.; thence S. 11° 03' W. 121 ft.; thence S. 55° 14' E. 95 ft.; thence N. 67° 02' E. 26.8 ft.; thence N. 26° 14' E. 150 ft.; thence N. 21° 15' W. 35.6 ft. to an iron pipe; thence N. 28° 35' W. 25.8 ft.; thence N. 50° 15' W. 91 ft.; thence N. 1° 14' E. 20 ft.; thence N. 65° 12' E. 122 ft.; thence S. 20° 20' E. 93.5 ft.; thence N. 63° 31' W. 114 ft.; thence N. 12° 04' E. 132 ft.; thence N. 60° 18' E. 72.4 ft. to the N.C. intersecting the N. 1/4 line Sec. 25 on N. shore of small bay (iron pipe) thence N. 3° 15' E. on 1/4 line 140.4 ft. to 1/4 cor. the point of beginning.

Commencing at the South 1/4 cor. of Sec. 25 (an iron pipe) distant 223.3 ft. on the South 1/4 line a distance of 223.3 ft.; thence N. 2° 08' E. 23.7 ft. to an iron pipe the place of beginning (from which an Oak tree 5" in dia. bears N. 40° E. 2.3 ft. distant and an Oak tree 7" in dia. bears N. 10° W. 2.1 ft. distant) thence N. 40° E. 100 ft.; thence N. 50° 45' W. 98.3 ft.; thence S. 80° 29' W. 100 ft.; thence S. 10° 30' E. 120 ft.; thence N. 50° 14' E. 123.5 ft.; thence S. 80° 29' W. 100 ft.; thence N. 75° 51' E. 34.8 ft. to an iron pipe and the place of beginning.
