Surveyor's Certificate

We hereby certify that we have surveyed and established the compromised division line between the L. A. Taylor and Bertha Mayo properties situated in Gov't. Lot 1, Sec. 19, T. 35 N. R. 11 E. of the 4th Principal Meridian, Oneida County, Wisconsin described as follows: Commencing at the Meander Corner between Secs. 18 and 19 on the easterly shore of Pelican Lake; thence N. 86° 47' E. on the Section Line common to Sec. 18 and Sec. 19 a distance of 189 feet to an iron pipe marking the intersection with the Westerly right-of-way line of U. S. H. No. 45 and State Trunk Highway No. 47; thence S. 52° 52' E. along said right-of-way line a distance of 427.6 feet to an iron pipe and the point of beginning of the compromised division line; thence S. 75° 23' W. a distance of 42.5 feet to an iron pipe situated on the Easterly shore of Pelican Lake the same being the terminal point of this line and from which a Norway Pine tree 12 inches in diameter bears N. 1° 00' E. 31 feet distant.

We further certify that this map is a true and correct representation of the lands so surveyed by us.


