



Survey of the Center Line of
the Abandoned
Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad
in
T36N,R6E; T37N,R6E; T37N,R7E; T38N,R6E; T39N,R6E
Oneida County, Wisconsin

This survey is based on the CMSP&P Railroad center line survey map approved by the Secretary of the Interior at Washington DC, April 25, 1887, and the apparent recovered center line of the abandoned tracks. Slight adjustments in the curve data were necessary to make the actual center line and the 1887 map agree. Field evidence was considered controlling over map data. Angles were measured with a Wild T1A transit, serial No 62876, using the mean of four repetitions. Distances were measured with a Geodimeter "76", serial No 1712. Two measurements were recorded in English units and two in metric units.

Map bearing is based on an evaluation of solar observations made at approximately 15 station intervals which varied from 0°01'00" CW to 0°01'18" CCW. No adjustments were made for convergency of meridians. A check traverse was run on USH "51" from Heafford Junction to Minocqua. Map bearing is 0°00'22" CW of the C. & G. S. Bearskin station azimuth mark bearing.

Monuments are cast aluminum break off type with 3" caps bearing the legend "STATE OF WISCONSIN SURVEY MARKER" and the appropriate identification, unless otherwise noted on map. Monuments were buried from 6" to 18" below the surface of the grade.

Section and subdivision lines shown on the maps are diagrammatic, and for illustrative purposes only.
