
SUPPLEMENTAL PLAT OF SECTION 33


THIS PLAT IS BASED UPON A REESTAGLISH SET OF THE LINES DEFINING LANDS 1 SEC. 33, T. 37 N., R. C. E., 4TH PRIN. MER., WASCONSIN, AS SHOWN UPON THE OFFICIAL PLAT APPROVED MARCH TO, 1064, IN THEIR TRUE ORT I AL POSITIONS ACCORDING TO THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL CORNERS, AND UPON A: EXTENSION SURVEY INCLUDING PUBLIC LAIDS NOT SHOWN ON SAID PLAT. THE ORIGINAL LINES HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AND THE ORIGINAL CORTERS REMONUMENTED WITH REGULATION IRON, POSTS. ALL DIFFERENCES IN MEASUREMENT BETWEEL THOSE SHOWN ON THE OPIGINAL PLAT AND THOSE DERIVED IN RETRACEMENT HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED PROPORTIONALLY BETWEEN ACCEPTED CORMERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SURVEYING RULES.

THE HEAVY IRREGULAR LINE DELINEATES THE POSITION OF THE LEADER LINE OF A LAKE IN SEC. 33 AS REPRESENTED ON THE PLAT OF THE ORIGINAL SURVEY. PORTIONS OF THIS MEANDER LINE WERE ERROLEOUSLY SURVEYED AND THESE PORTIONS HAVE
BEEN REESTABLISHED AS A FIXED LIMITING COUNDARY OF THE ORIGINAL SUBDIVISIONS ADJACENT THERETO, WITH ADJUSTED COURSES AND DISTANCES BASED UPON THE RECORD OF THE ORIGINAL SURVEY.

ALL SUBDIVISIONS SHOWN ON THE ORIGINAL PLAT REMAIN UNDISTURBED FOR POSITION A D DESCRIPTION. THE AREAS OF ORIGINAL LOTS 3, 4 AND 5 ARE SHOW I. TO PARTS: 1/" DELOTING LAND AREA AND "P" DENOTING WATER MEAR THESE "A" AND "B" AREAS ARE CO. PUTED PROPERTICALLY, ACCORDING TO THE TOTAL AREAS OF THE ORIGINAL SUCULVISIO 6.

LOTS 8, 9, 13 And 14 ARE INVADED BY A LOCAL SUBDIVISION KNOWN AS "UNITY POINT." SEE INSERT DIAGRAL FOR SHOWING OF POSITION OF LOTS IN THAT SUBDIVISION.

DISTANCES AND BEARINGS SHOWN IN PARENTHESES ARE COMPUTED. ALL LOT CORNERS ARE MARKED WITH WOODEN STAKES, 1 X 6 INCHES, 6 INCHES ABOVE GROUND, PAINTED WHITE, WITH THE LOT NUMBERS STENCILED THEREON. THIS DIAGRAM AFFORDS A BASIS FOR THE DISPOSAL OF THE PUBLIC EAND AREA OF THE LOTS OF UNITY POINT SUBDIVISION, IN LOTS 9 % 13, SEC. 33.
