


NOTE Records indicate on Dec. 30, 1947, Borge acquired the lands in Section 28 and subsequently had F.R Wincentsen of Genisot Engineering subdivide Section 28 on Oct 22, 1948 Gov t. Lot 6 was further subdivided into lots on Jan 30, 1951 and subsequently conveyed. Evidently, this survey line by Wincentsen was intended to be the dividing line between the North and South half of Gov t.

One could interpret an overlap in the area of this line, since the G.L O changed its South line of Section 28 in 1952. Carlson would have senior rights to the line as monumented since Borge initially conveyed the same parcel to Herminath and Allender on May 17, 1951 and later conveyed the South half of Gov t. Lot 6 to Musson on Aug. 24, 1951.
