TUYLS PARCEL

A parcel of land in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, Section 26, Township 37 North, Range 6 East, Cassian Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, being the "TUYLS PARCEL" shown on Map No. 94-130 by Wilderness Surveying, Inc. dated September 28th, 1994, more particularly described as follows:


Commencing at the northwest corner of said Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, being the quarter corner common to Sections 26 and 27, marked by a railroad spike in the pavement of U.S. Highway "51", thence South 00 degrees 31 minutes 56 seconds East for a distance of 1242.01 feet to the southwest corner of said Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, being the South Sixteenth Corner, marked by an aluminum capped iron pipe, thence South 88 degrees 37 minutes 42 seconds East for a distance of 506.22 feet along the south line of said Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter to the place of beginning, marked by an iron pipe on the easterly right of way line of U.S. Highway "51".

Thence continuing South 88 degrees 37 minutes 42 seconds East for a distance of 688.08 feet along the south line of said Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter to an iron pipe, thence North 00 degrees 34 minutes 44 seconds West for a distance of 271.56 feet to an iron pipe, thence North 88 degrees 37 minutes 42 seconds West for a distance of 911.60 feet to an iron pipe on the easterly right of way line of U.S. Highway "51", thence along the easterly right of said U.S. Highway "51", along a curve to the left, having a radius of 1372.39 feet and an arc length of 148.44 feet, being subtended by a chord of South 37 degrees 26 minutes 00 seconds East for a distance of 148.37 feet to an iron pipe, thence continuing along said right of way line South 40 degrees 31 minutes 54 seconds East for a distance of 209.30 feet to the place of beginning.

Together with and subject to covenants, easements, and restrictions of record.

Said property contains 5.01 acres.
