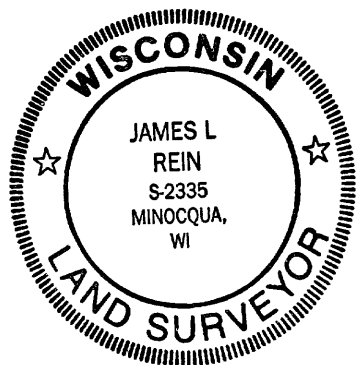

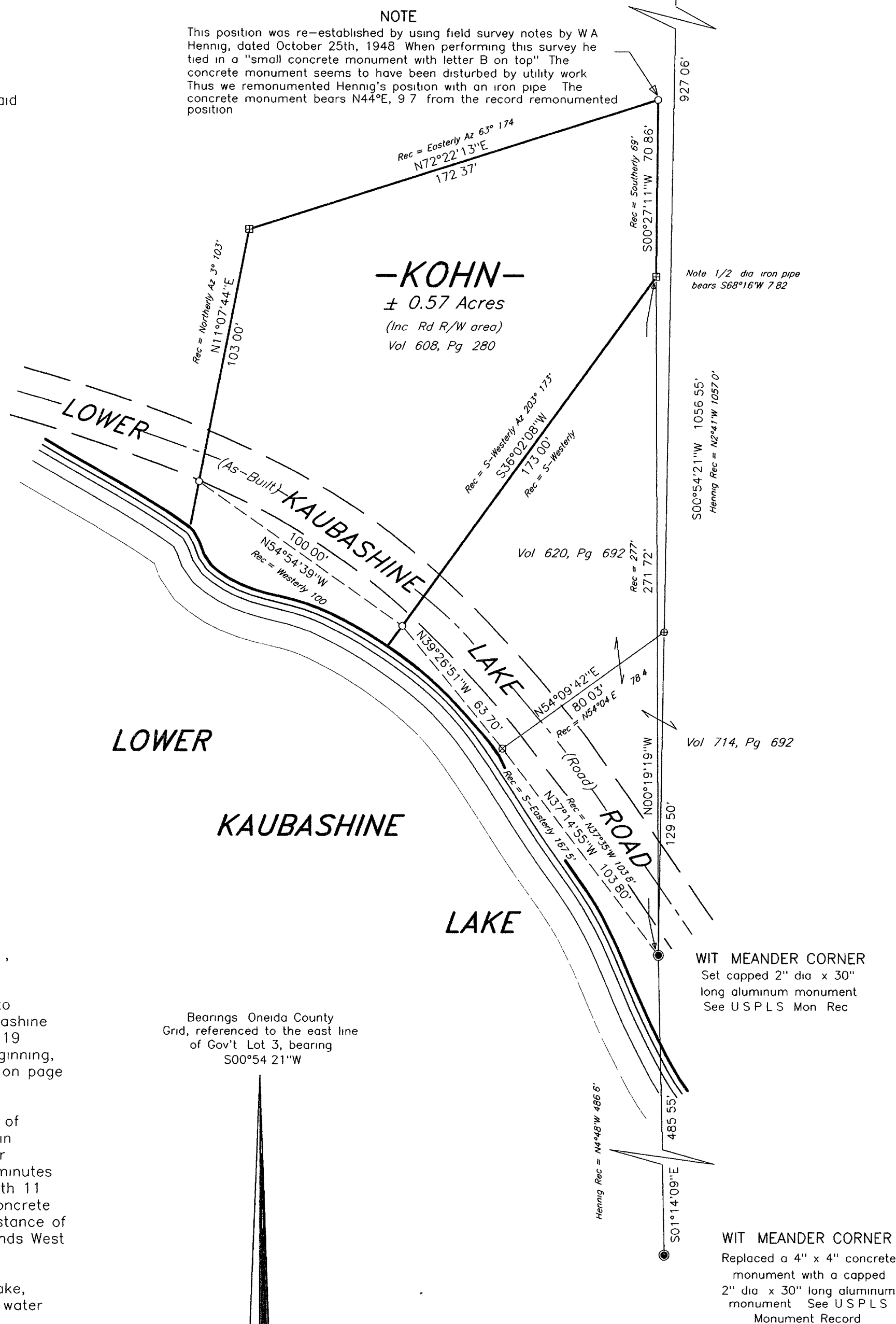

NOTE

This position was re-established by using field survey notes by WA Hennig, dated October 25th, 1948. When performing this survey he tied in a "small concrete monument with letter B on top". The concrete monument seems to have been disturbed by utility work. Thus we remonumented Hennig's position with an iron pipe. The concrete monument bears N44°E, 9.7' from the record remonumented position.



KOHN (Map No 99-203)

A parcel of land in Government Lot 3, Section 4, Township 38 North, Range 6 East, Hazelhurst Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, being the "KOHN" parcel as shown on Map No 99-203 by Wilderness Surveying, Inc., dated March 8, 2000, more particularly described as follows

Commencing at the Witness Meander Corner, where the line common to Section 3 and Section 4 intersects the north-easterly shore of Lower Kaubashine Lake, marked by a capped aluminum monument, thence North 00 degrees 19 minutes 19 seconds West for a distance of 271.72 feet to the place of beginning, being the northerly corner of that parcel of land described in Volume 620, on page 692, marked by a concrete monument

Thence South 36 degrees 02 minutes 08 seconds West for a distance of 173.00 feet along the north-westerly line of that parcel of land described in Volume 620, on page 692, to an iron pipe near the easterly shore of Lower Kaubashine Lake, thence meandering along the lake North 54 degrees 54 minutes 39 seconds West for a distance of 100.00 feet to an iron pipe, thence North 11 degrees 07 minutes 44 seconds East for a distance of 103.00 feet to a concrete monument, thence North 72 degrees 22 minutes 13 seconds East for a distance of 172.37 feet to an iron pipe, thence South 00 degrees 27 minutes 11 seconds West for a distance of 70.86 feet to the place of beginning

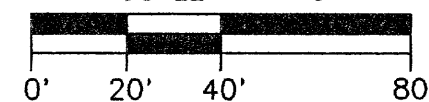
The above lateral lot lines extend to the shore of Lower Kaubashine Lake, and include all lands lying between the meander line and the ordinary high water mark
