A parcel of land previously described in Volume 815 of Records, on page 7, located in Government Lot 2, Section 22, Township 38 North, Range 7 East, Lake Tomahawk Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, being the "ZALEWSKI" parcel shown on Map No 99-153 by Wilderness Surveying, Inc., dated April 17th, 2000, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the quarter corner common to Sections 15 and 22, marked by a capped aluminum monument, thence South 01 degrees 47 minutes 37 seconds East for a distance of 458 00 feet, thence South 88 degrees 47 minutes 10 seconds West for a distance of 1006 22 feet to an iron pipe, thence South 03 degrees 30 minutes 33 seconds East for a distance of 190 73 feet to an iron pipe, thence South 37 degrees 49 minutes 48 seconds East for a distance of 139 01 feet to the place of beginning, marked by a well point located within the right of way of Starling

Thence South 28 degrees 36 minutes 39 seconds East for a distance of 49 96 feet to an iron pipe within the right of way of Starling Lane, thence South 60 degrees 11 minutes 19 seconds East for a distance of 9 99 feet to an iron pipe within the right of way of said Starling Lane, thence South 68 degrees 11 minutes 37 seconds West for a distance of 278 01 feet to an iron pipe near the easterly shore of South Two Lakes, thence meandering along the lake North 46 degrees 46 minutes 22 seconds West for a distance of 30 11 feet to an iron pipe, thence continuing along the lake North 45 degrees 40 minutes 53 seconds West for a distance of 98 03 feet to an iron pipe, thence North 78 degrees 46 minutes 56 seconds East for a distance of 323.79 feet to the place of beginning place of beginning
