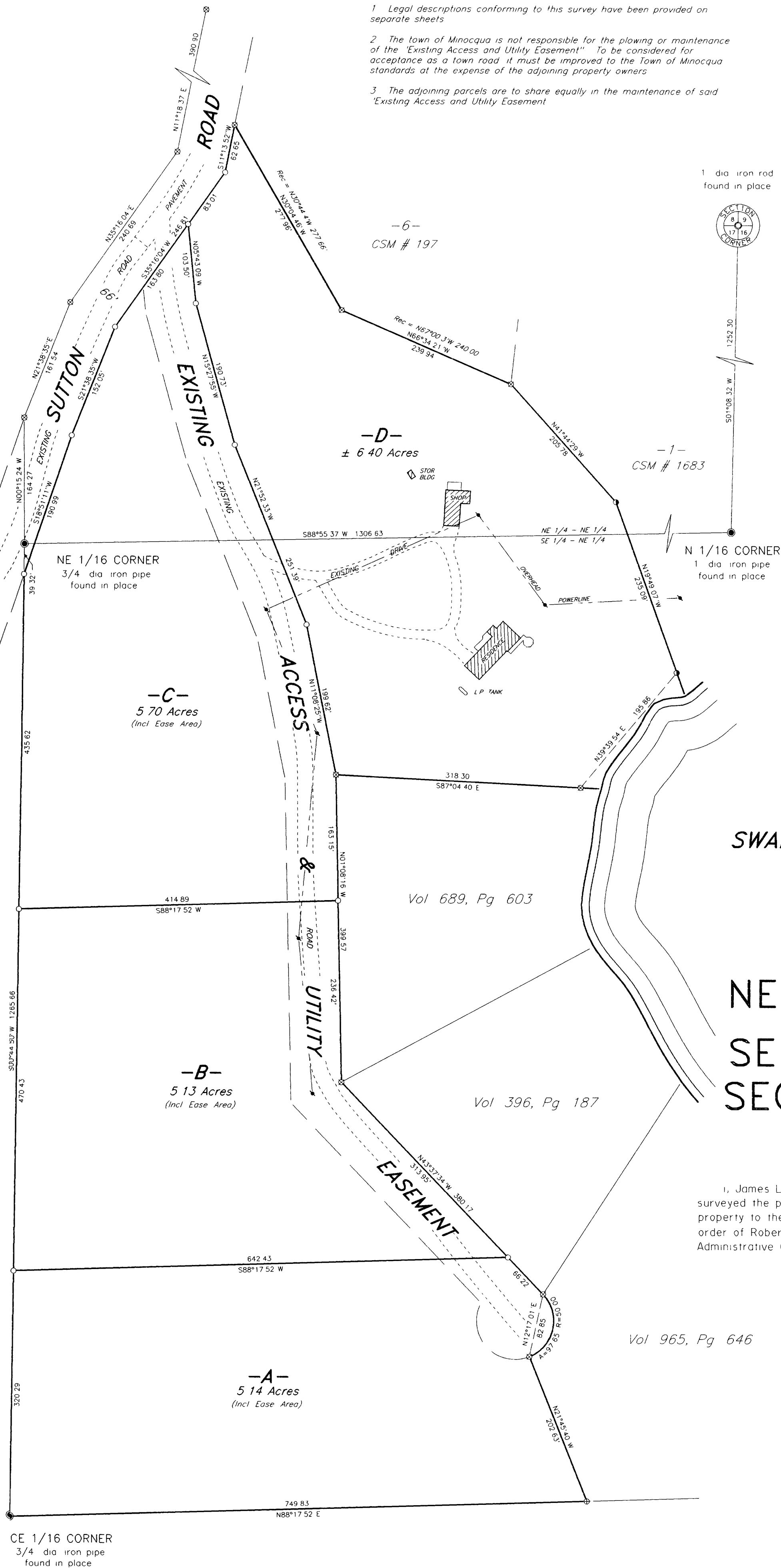

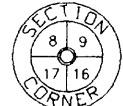
1. Legal descriptions conforming to this survey have been provided on separate sheets

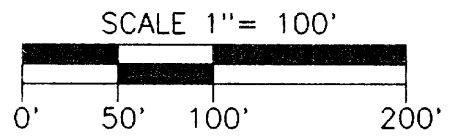


1 dia iron rod
