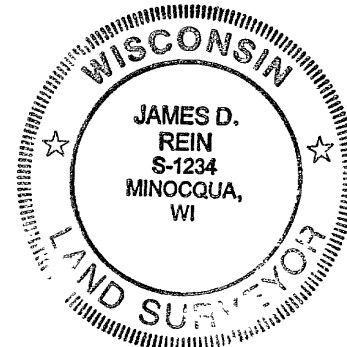

KRAMER PARCEL 5 (Map No. 01-247)

A parcel of land previously described in Volume 389 Records, on page 61, located in Government Lot 4, Section 28, Township 39 North Range 10 East, Sugar Camp Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, being the "KRAMER" parcel shown on Map No. 01-247 by Wilderness Surveying, Inc., dated December 21, 2001, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Government Lot 4, being the quarter corner common to Section 27 and Section 28, marked by a capped aluminum monument, thence South 00 degrees 49 minutes 19 seconds West for a distance of 599.99 feet along the east line of Government Lot 4 to the place of beginning, marked by an iron pipe.

Thence continuing South 00 degrees 49 minutes 19 seconds West for a distance of 149.90 feet along the east line of Government Lot 4 to an iron pipe, thence North 87 degrees 40 minutes 07 seconds West for a distance of 1458.25 feet to an iron pipe near the easterly shore of Columbus Lake, thence meandering along the lake North 07 degrees 16 minutes 27 seconds East for a distance of 160.01 feet to an iron pipe, thence South 87 degrees 17 minutes 18 seconds East for a distance of 1440.55 feet to the place of beginning.

The above lateral lot lines extend to Columbus Lake and include all lands lying between the meander line and the ordinary highwater mark.

Together with and subject to covenants, easements, and restrictions of record.

Said property contains 5.14 acres, more or less.

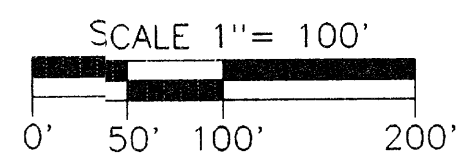
Capped 2.4" dia. aluminum monument found in place.

 S00°49'19" W

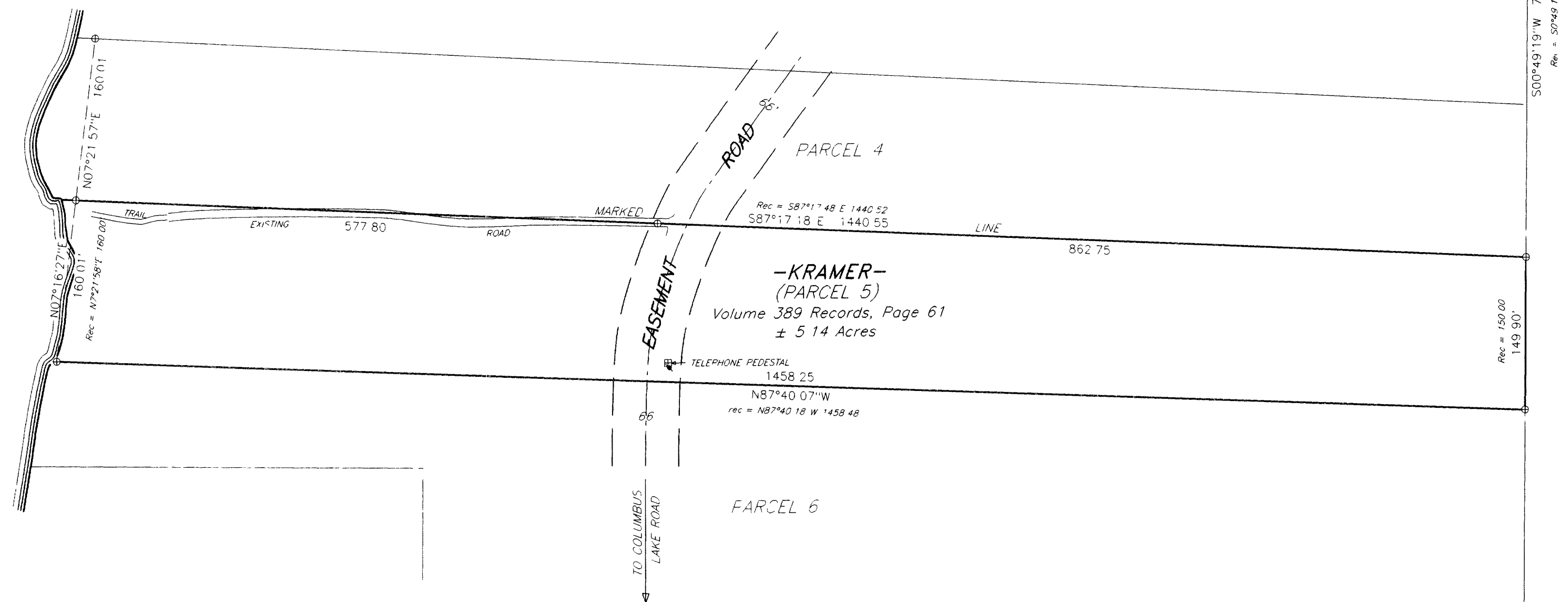
COLUMBUS
