

Rein, Registered Land Surveyor No. S-1234, hereby certify that I have surveyed the property shown hereon; that this map represents an accurate survey of said property to the best of my knowledge and belief; that I have performed this survey by order of Linda & Gerald Mroczkowski; and that I have complied with the requirements of Wisconsin Administrative Code A-E 7.





MROCZKOWSKI PARCEL (Map No. 10-83)

A parcel of land previously described in Document Number 635289, located in Government Lot 2, Section 9, Township 39 North, Range 4 East, Town of Minocqua, Oneida County, Wisconsin, being the "MROCZKOWSKI" parcel shown on Map Number 10-83, by Wilderness Surveying, Inc., dated July 27th, 2010, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Section 9, marked by an Oneida County capped Aluminum monument; thence South 88 degrees 41 minutes 08 seconds West for a distance of 1118.34 feet along the north line of Section 9 to the Meander Corner, marked by an aluminum capped iron pipe near the easterly shore of Squaw Lake; thence South 43 degrees 25 minutes 57 seconds West for a distance of 499.72 feet to the place of beginning, marked by an iron pipe near the southerly shore of Squaw Lake.

Thence South 40 degrees 53 minutes 43 seconds East for a distance of 182.95 feet to an iron pipe; thence South 63 degrees 56 minutes 10 seconds West for a distance of 75.11 feet to an iron pipe; thence North 40 degrees 52 minutes 36 seconds West for a distance of 54.77 feet to an iron pipe; thence South 78 degrees 49 minutes 10 seconds West for a distance of 65.33 feet to an iron pipe; thence North 22 degrees 53 minutes 25 seconds West for a distance of 102.39 feet to an iron pipe near the southerly shore of Squaw Lake; thence meandering along said lake, North 61 degrees 07 minutes 45 seconds East for a distance of 99.87 feet to the place of beginning.

The above described lateral lot lines extend to Squaw Lake including all those lands lying between the meander line and the ordinary high water mark.

Together with and subject to covenants, easements, and restrictions of record.

Said property contains 0.44 acres, more or less.
