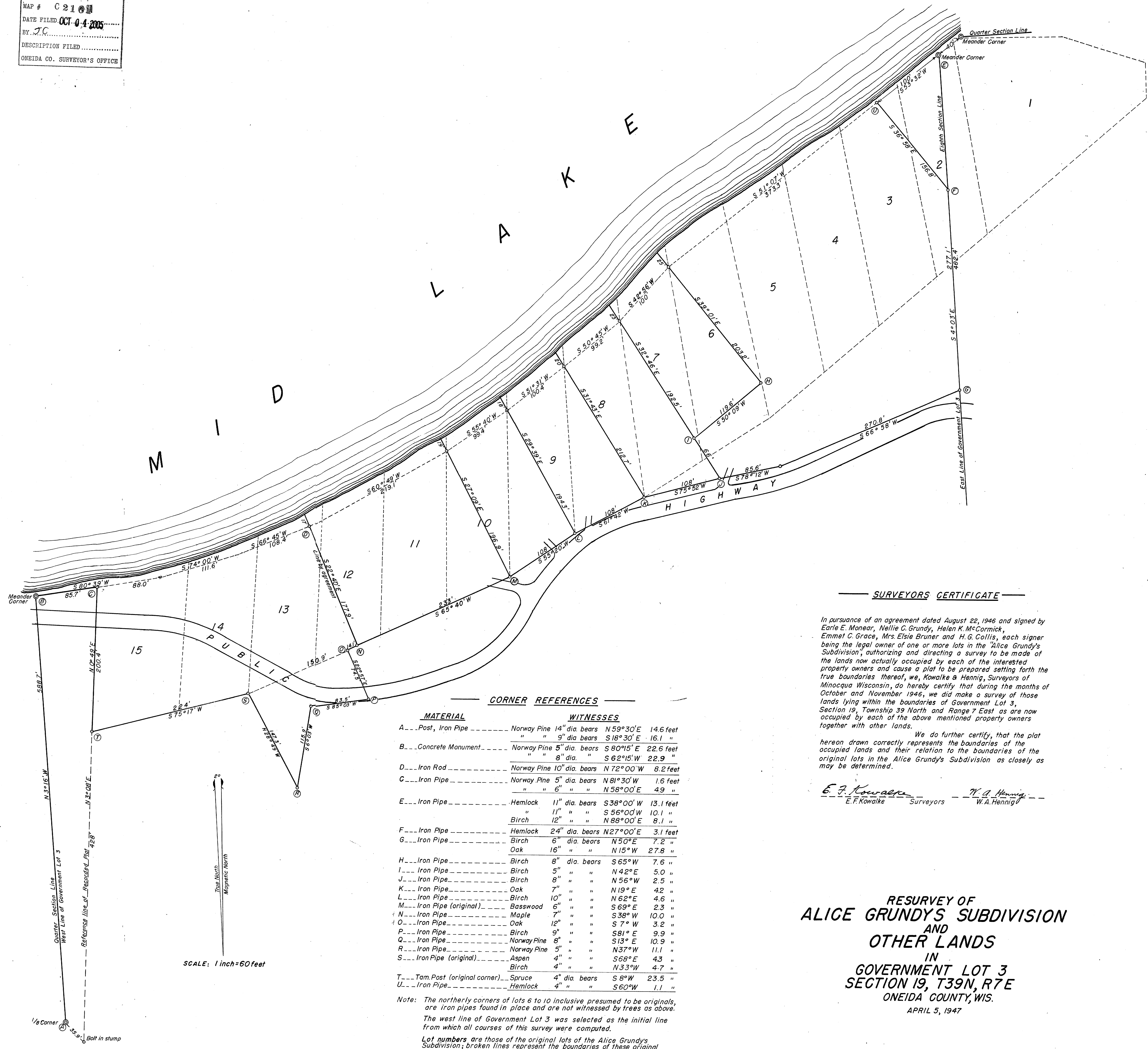

Note: The northerly corners of lots 6 to 10 inclusive presumed to be originals, are iron pipes found in place and are not witnessed by trees as above. The west line of Government Lot 3 was selected as the initial line from which all courses of this survey were computed. Lot numbers are those of the original lots of the Alice Grundy's Subdivision; broken lines represent the boundaries of these original lots as closely as can be determined.

SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE

In pursuance of an agreement dated August 22, 1946 and signed by Earle E. Monear, Nellie C. Grundy, Helen K. McCormick, Emmet C. Grace, Mrs. Elsie Bruner and H. G. Collis, each signer being the legal owner of one or more lots in the Alice Grundy's Subdivision, authorizing and directing a survey to be made of the lands now actually occupied by each of the interested property owners and cause a plat to be prepared setting forth the true boundaries thereof, we, Kowalke & Hennig, Surveyors of Minocqua Wisconsin, do hereby certify that during the months of October and November 1946, we did make a survey of those lands lying within the boundaries of Government Lot 3, Section 19, Township 39 North and Range 7 East as are now occupied by each of the above mentioned property owners together with other lands.

We do further certify, that the plat hereon drawn correctly represents the boundaries of the occupied lands and their relation to the boundaries of the original lots in the Alice Grundy's Subdivision as closely as may be determined.
