

Surveyors Certificate

I, Harry C. Hall, do hereby certify, that, in September, 1937 at the request of the Town of Three Lakes, Oneida County, Wis. I made a survey of the location of a Town Road in part of Govt. Lot (1) Sec. 31-39-11-E. That the map hereon drawn correctly represents my survey; That the north and south boundary of the east end of this road has been located and identified by distances and bearing trees. The north side for more than 33 years and the south side for more than 29 years; That the long cut at east end is 30 feet wide at top and bearing trees are at edge of cut or 15 feet from center of traveled way; That the turnpiked portion ranges from 14 to 18 feet in width; That this old road was the original outlet west for the people living on Govt. Lot (7) to the east as shown. That the following deeds verify this statement; (Vol. 46 - Pg. 194 of Deeds - Jan. 13 - 1904 for the north side) and (Vol. 50 - Pg. 50 of Deeds - Dec. 16 - 1907 for the south side).
