SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, KEITH M. HALL, HEREBY CERTIFY THAT I HAVE, DURING PARTS OF YEARS '48-51-55-SURVEYED IN SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 37 NORTH, RANGE 8 EAST, ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN, AS FOLLOWS; FOUND D.H. VAUGHAN'S WEST 1/4 TH CORNER AS PERPETUATED BY HARRY C. HALL; RAN EAST ON THIS 1/4 TH LINE THRU THE D.H. VAUGHAN CENTER AND SET A STEEL FENCE POST TO PERPETUATE THIS CORNER; SET IRON PIPE ON ISLAND FOR WEST 1/8 AND CONTINUE EAST TO WISCONSIN RIVER WHERE I SET IRON PIPE FOR MEANDER CORNER; FIND D.H. VAUGHAN'S SOUTH 1/4 TH CORNER IN TOWN ROAD; RUN NORTH ON 1/4 TH LINE THRU THE AFORESAID CENTER OF SECTION 23, SETTING THE 1/8 TH SOUTH OF CENTER, THE 1/8 TH NORTH OF CENTER AND PERPETUATED NORTH 1/4 TH CORNER WITH AN IRON PIPE; RAN NORTH FROM 1/8 TH WEST OF CENTER, SETTING IRON PIPE FOR MEANDER CORNER ON NORTH SHORE OF WILDWOOD LAKE; CONTINUE ON THIS LINE SETTING 1/16 TH CORNER AND IRON PIPE AT D.H. VAUGHAN'S 1/8 TH CORNER ON NORTH LINE OF SECTION; RAN EAST FROM NORTH 1/4 CORNER, SET MEANDER CORNER ON BANK OF WISCONSIN RIVER; RUN EAST FROM 1/8 TH NORTH OF THE CENTER TO THE WISCONSIN RIVER, SET M.C. BETWEEN GOV. LOTS 3 & 4; RAN EAST HALF OF SOUTH SECTION LINE, FINDING AND PERPETUATING D.H. VAUGHAN'S EAST 1/8 TH CORNER ON THIS LINE AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THIS SECTION; RAN NORTH FROM EAST 1/8 TH ON SAID SOUTH LINE - PARALLEL HIS NORTH AND SOUTH 1/4 TH LINE, AS HE CLAIMS TO HAVE DONE, AND ESTABLISHED THE LINE BETWEEN GOV. LOTS 7 AND 8 AS SHOWN ABOVE, SETTING AN IRON PIPE FOR THE SOUTH EAST CORNER OF GOV. LOT 7 AND AN IRON PIPE FOR THE MEANDER CORNER ON THE SHORE OF THE WISCONSIN RIVER BETWEEN GOV. LOTS 7 AND 8; THE RECESSION OF THE SHORELINE DUE TO THE ACTION OF ICE AND WATER HAS OBLITERATED THE VAUGHAN M.C. OF FORTY YEARS AGO, FROM HIS FIGURES IT WOULD APPEAR TO HAVE BEEN A CHAIN OR MORE FARTHER OUT THAN MY M.C. ON THE PRESENT SHORELINE. I FURTHER CERTIFY THAT I HAVE PREPARED THE SEVEN METES AND BOUNDS PARCELS OF LAND OF MORE THAN 1.5 ACRES EACH, PARALLEL THE EAST LINE OF GOV. LOT 7 AS SHOWN ABOVE AND MADE PROVISION FOR NEW TOWN ROAD TO SERVE THESE PARCELS. THE INFORMATION GIVEN HEREIN AND THIS MAP PREPARED BY ME ARE TO THE BEST OF MY KNOWLEDGE AND BELIEF A CORRECT REPRESENTATION OF MY SURVEYS IN THIS SECTION.
