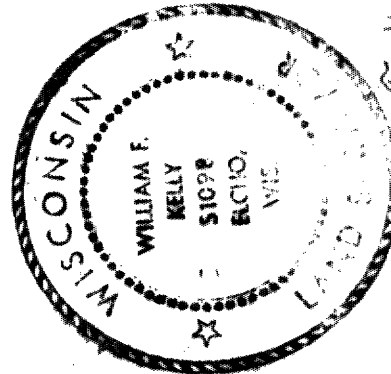

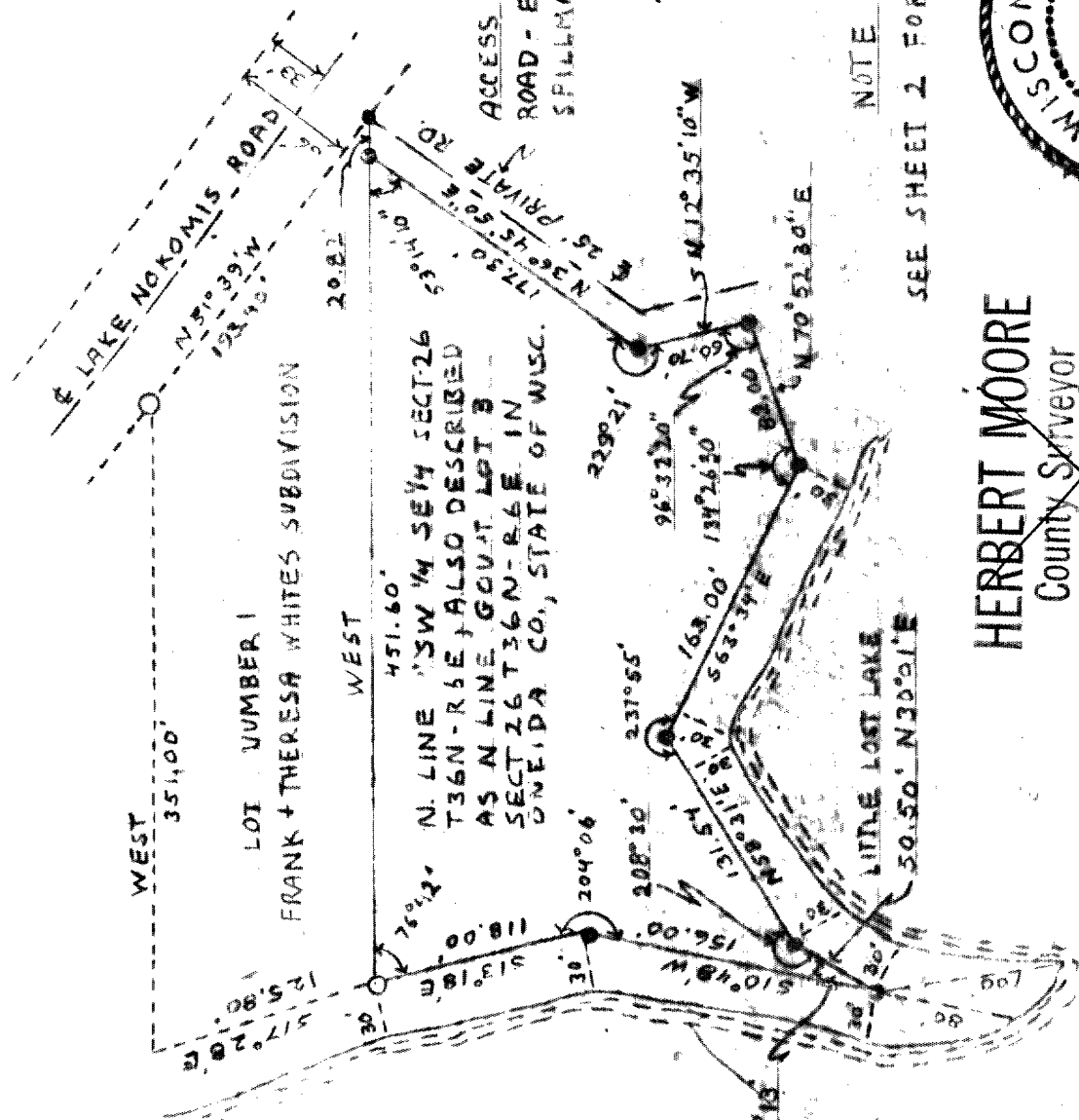
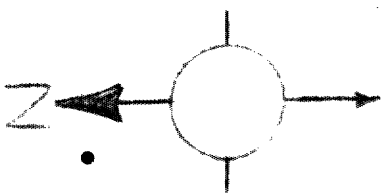

DESCRIPTION

Plot of Survey for Eugene Spillman of Carpentersville, Illinois of a parcel of Land in Gov't Lot 3 of Sec 26 T. 36 N. - R. 6 E. in Oneida County, State of Wisconsin described as follows: Commencing at the N.E. Corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sect. 26 T. 36 N. - R. 6 E; said corner being the NE Corner of Gov't Lot 3 in said Sect 26; thence running West on the North Line said Gov't Lot 3 in said Sect 26 20.82 ft. to the point of real beginning; said North Line Gov't Lot 3 is the South Boundary of Lot No 1 in Frank & Theresa Whites Subdivision as recorded; thence continuing West on North Line Gov't Lot 3 451.60 ft. to an Iron Pipe; thence S $13^{\circ}28'E$ - 118.00 ft.; thence S $12^{\circ}48'W$ - 156.00 ft.; thence N $30^{\circ}01'E$ - 50.50 ft.; thence N $58^{\circ}31'E$ - 131.54 ft.; thence S $53^{\circ}34'E$ - 163.00 ft.; thence N $70^{\circ}52'30"E$ - 82.00 ft.; thence N $12^{\circ}25'10"W$ - 60.70 ft.; thence N $36^{\circ}45'50"E$ 177.30 ft. to the point of real beginning. Said parcel contains all lands as described above and is behind a strip of Land 30.00 ft. in width which is above and contiguous to the flowage caused by a dam across the Tomahawk River. Said parcel has an Existing right of way easement for Wisconsin Public Service lines across it.
