
PLAT OF SURVEY U S GOVERNMENT LAND



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SURVEY NOTES

This survey was made by North Country Surveyors persuant to United States Department of Agriculture, Forest Service Contract No 53-56A6-4-00035, Cadastral Survey for the purpose of recovering, restoring, establishing, marking and perpetuating the corners and boundary lines of the U S Government land on the perimeter and within Section 1, T38N, R11E, Fourth Frincipal Meridian, Oneida, County, Wisconsin as shown on the plat herewith

The original Government Survey of the North Township line was completed by Hiram C Fellows in 1859. The East line of the Township was surveyed by Alfred Millard in 1858. The remainder of the Township was surveyed by Alfred Millard in 1859.

Two Dependent Resurveys have been made which are used for the control of this survey and established the elterior corners of Section 1. In 1937 the Range line between R11E and R12E was re-surveyed which established and monumented the corners on the East Section line. In 1941 a Dependent Resurvey of Sections 1,2,11 to 14, 23 to 26, 35, and 36 established and monumented the corners for the remainder of the section.

Bearings between corner positions are true bearings by reference to a solar observation. All distances shown thereon are in feet and hundredths of feet. The control traverse was measured by use of electronic distance measuring equipment. Corners recovered, restored and established by this survey are marked by the monument described in the map legend. Each monumented corner position is referenced to blazed and scribed bearing trees and described reference objects.
