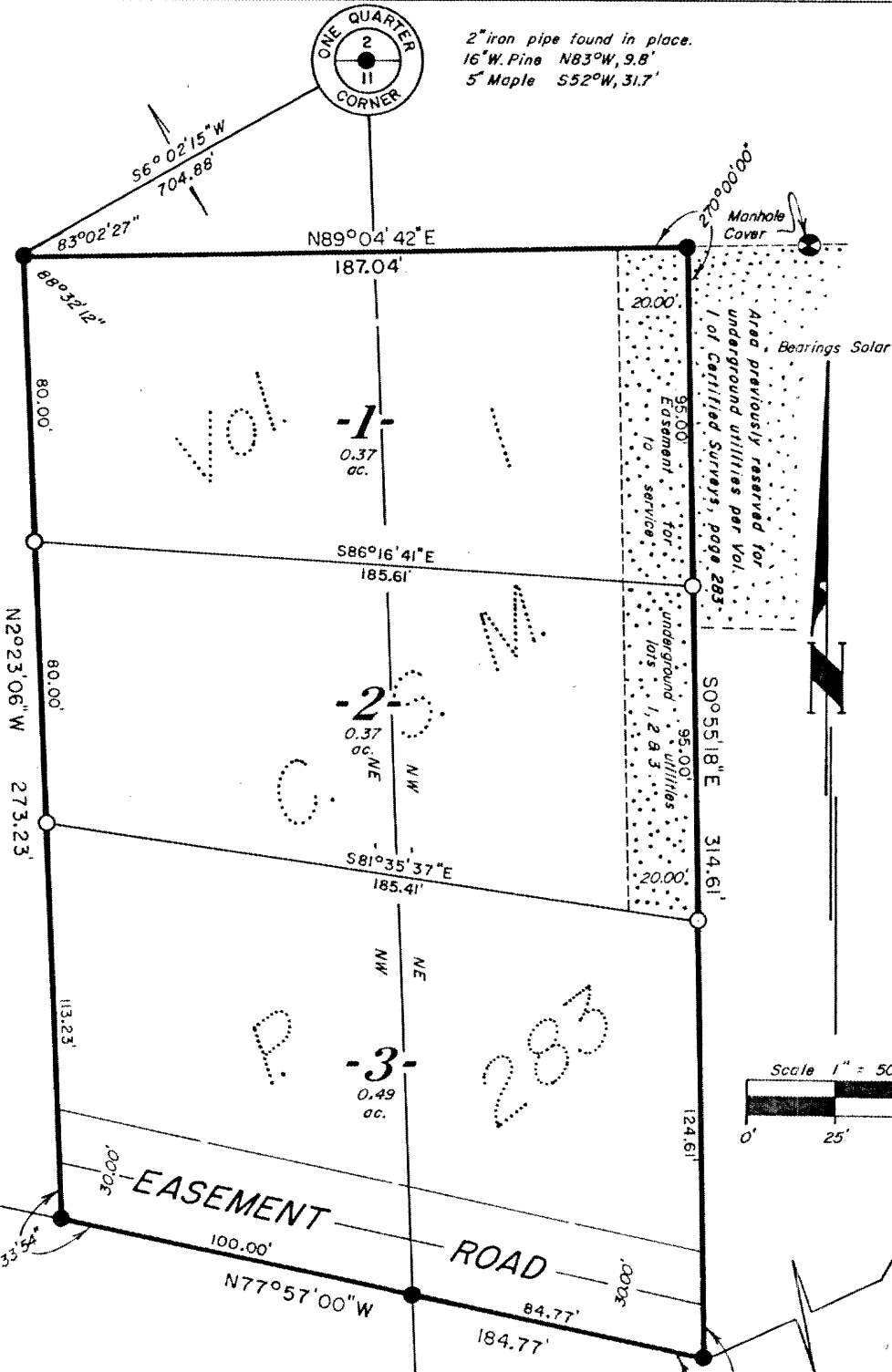

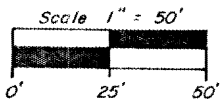

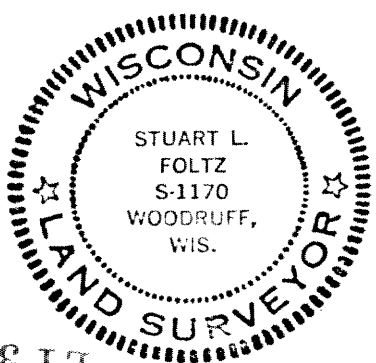


- = 2" Iron pipe previously set by this firm.

STATE - HWY. - "70"

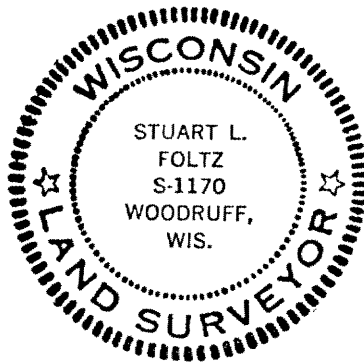
U.S. HWY. "51"

A parcel of land in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4, Section 11, T39N, R6E, Minocqua Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, previously recorded as Lot 2 of that Certified Survey Map recorded in Volume 1 of Certified Survey Maps on page 283, and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the one quarter corner common to Sections 2 and 11, marked by a 2" iron pipe, witnessed by a 16" White Pine bearing N83°W, 9.8 feet and a 5" Maple bearing S52°W, 31.7 feet; thence S6°02'15"W, 704.88 feet to the place of beginning, marked by a 2" iron pipe.

Thence N89°04'42"E, 187.04 feet to a 2" iron pipe; thence S0°55'18"E, 314.61 feet to a 2" iron pipe on the northerly right of way line of State Highway "70"; thence N77°57'00"W, 184.77 feet along said right of way line to a 2" iron pipe; thence N2°23'06"W, 273.23 feet to the place of beginning.
