

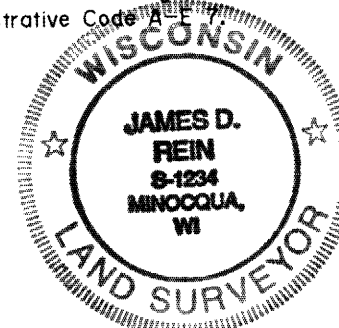

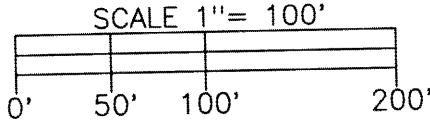
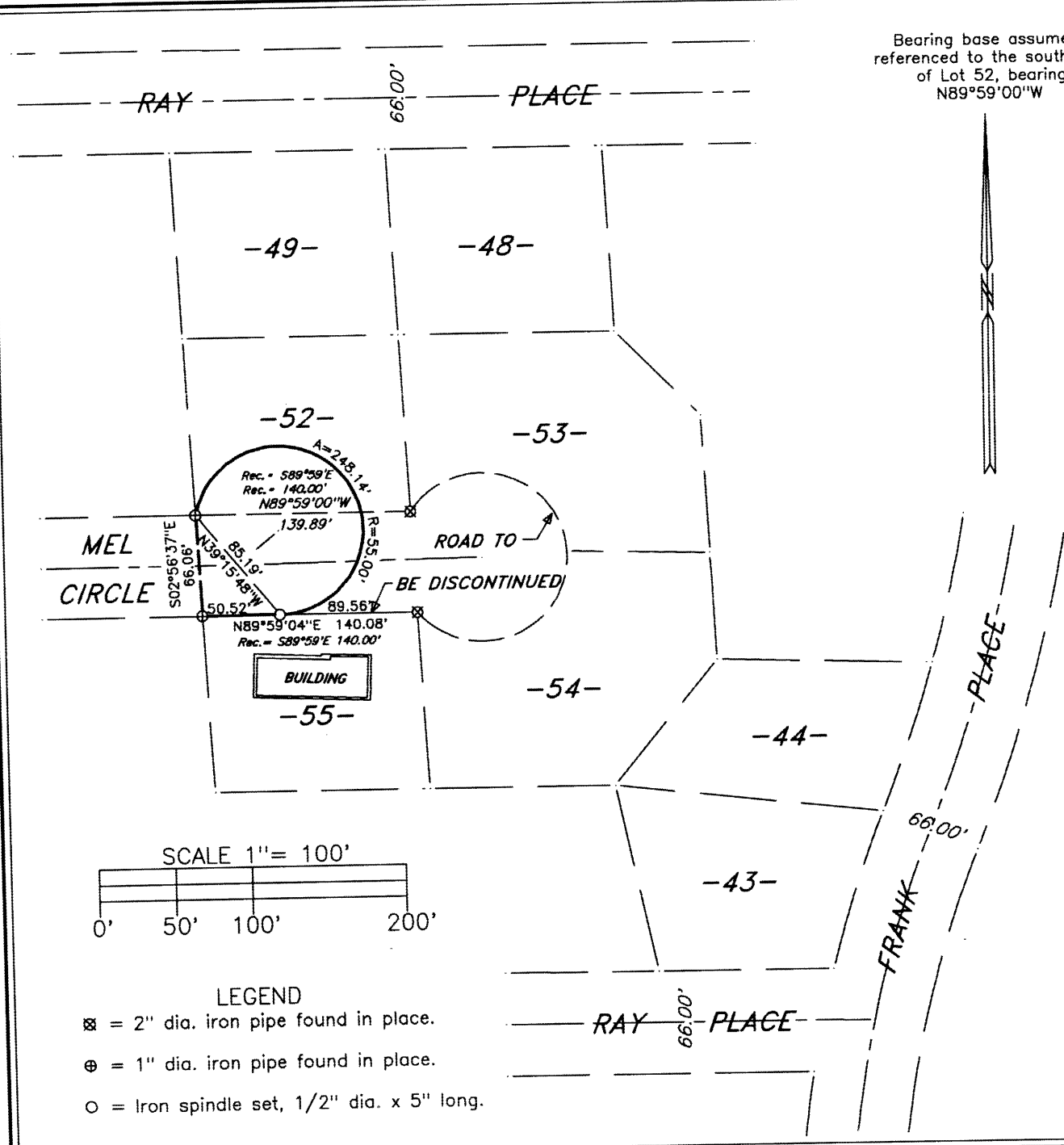

MEL CIRCLE DISCONTINUANCE AND RELOCATION

All that part of Mel Circle located between Lots 52, 53, 54 and 55 in the Plat of Lakeland Heights, located in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, Section 10, Township 39 North, Range 6 East, Minocqua Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, except a cul de sac described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 55 in the Plat of Lakeland Heights; thence along the north line of Lot 55, North 89 degrees 59 minutes 04 seconds East for a distance of 50.52 feet to an iron spindle; thence along a curve to the left having a radius of 55.00 feet and an arc length of 248.14 feet, being subtended by a chord of North 39 degrees 15 minutes 48 seconds West for a distance of 85.19 feet to the southwest corner of Lot 52 in the Plat of Lakeland Heights; thence South 02 degrees 56 minutes 37 seconds East for a distance of 66.06 feet to the place of beginning.
