That he then found all the Original 20 Post 1/2 section corners of
said section 4. That he then set the center of said section 4 from which a
white Pine 10 in bore N. 52 E 32 1/2 lks.

That he also set the 70 corner between said center & the S 1/2 Post
at a bearing of 13 in bore S 37 N 10 lks.

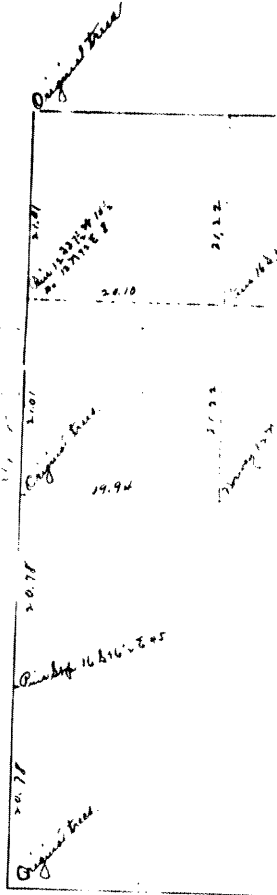
And further that on February 26th 1897 he ran from
said center 20.14 ch. to said 70 corner & there set a 1/2
Post - from which a white Pine stump 11 in bore S 36 N 20 1/4 lks.

doth deposes & say that on the 26th day of February 1897 they found with L. J.
Dorr to a point said by him to be the center of section 4 in Twp. 36 North, of
Range 9 East.

That from that point north easterly 32 1/2 links
there was a pine stump about 10 in in diameter marked S. B. E. & another pine
stump southeasterly 24 links about 11 in in diameter marked S. B. E.

That from said point they measured south 20.14
links to the 70 corner, from which a pine tree 10 in bore north
westerly 32 1/2 links & a bearing of 13 in bore south westerly 16 links.
Thereof measured south 20.14 ch. & set a stake from which a pine stump
11 in bore southeasterly 20 1/4 links & a pine stump 9 in bore north westerly
47 1/2 links.
