

Deputy's Certificate.

State of Wisconsin

J. F. Dorr, being duly sworn deposes & says, that in  
February, 1897 he subdivided section No. 4 in Twp. 86 North; of Range 9 East.  
That he then found all the original 2 Posts & section corner of  
said section 4. That he then set the center of said section 4 from which a  
white pine 10 in. b. m. 52 ft. 32  $\frac{1}{4}$  links.

" " 11 in. 41 ft. 29 links.  
That he also set the 2 corner between said center & the SW Post  
at the same time, & that from said 2 corners a white pine 10 in. b. m. 76 ft. 32 links.  
A monument is in line 137 N. 18 E.  
And further, that on February 26<sup>th</sup> 1897 he measured  
said center line 20.14 chs. to said 2 corners & thence south 20.14 chs. & set a 1/4  
post from which a white pine stump 11 in. b. m. 36 ft. 20  $\frac{1}{4}$  links.  
9 in. 20 ft. 67  $\frac{1}{4}$  links.  
And that Roy K. Smith & Mr. McBeattie measured the above mentioned distance over said  
26<sup>th</sup> day of February 1897.

Troy, Feb 26<sup>th</sup> 1897. W. McBeattie being duly sworn  
doth depose & say that on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of February 1897 they found with J. F.  
Dorr to a point said by him to be the center of Section 4 in Twp. 86 North; of  
Range 9 East.  
That from that point north easterly 32  $\frac{1}{4}$  links  
there was a pine stump about 10 in. in diameter marked 48.8 S. & another pine  
stump northerly 24 links about 11 in. in diameter marked 28.8 E.  
That from said point they measured south 20.14  
links west and to the 2 corners, from which a pine tree 10 in. b. m. 37  
links; & a tamarack 13 in. (broken down) bore south westerly 16 links.  
Thence measured south 20.14 chs. & set a stake from which a pine stump  
11 in. b. m. easterly 20  $\frac{1}{4}$  links & a pine stump 9 in. b. m. northerly  
47  $\frac{1}{4}$  links.


