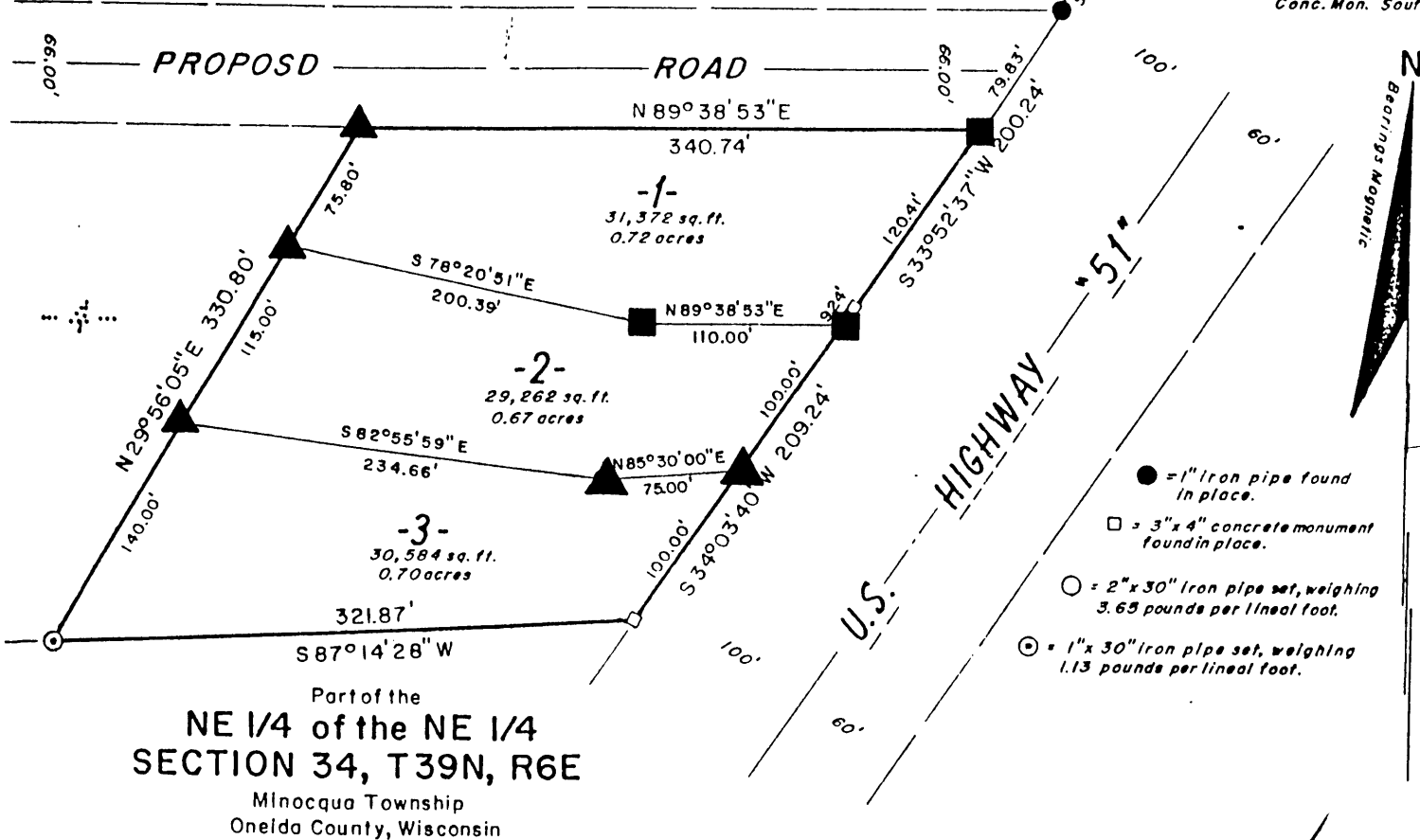

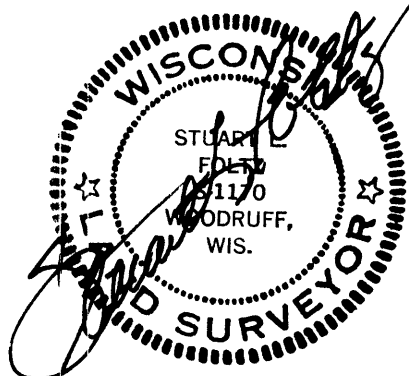


Set railroad spike over iron shaft 3' south of a.
