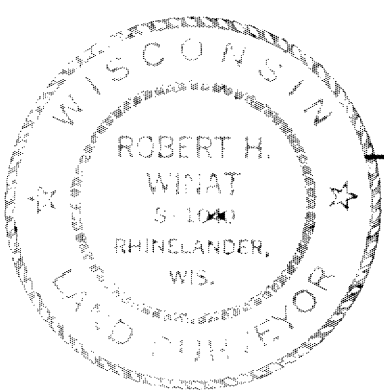

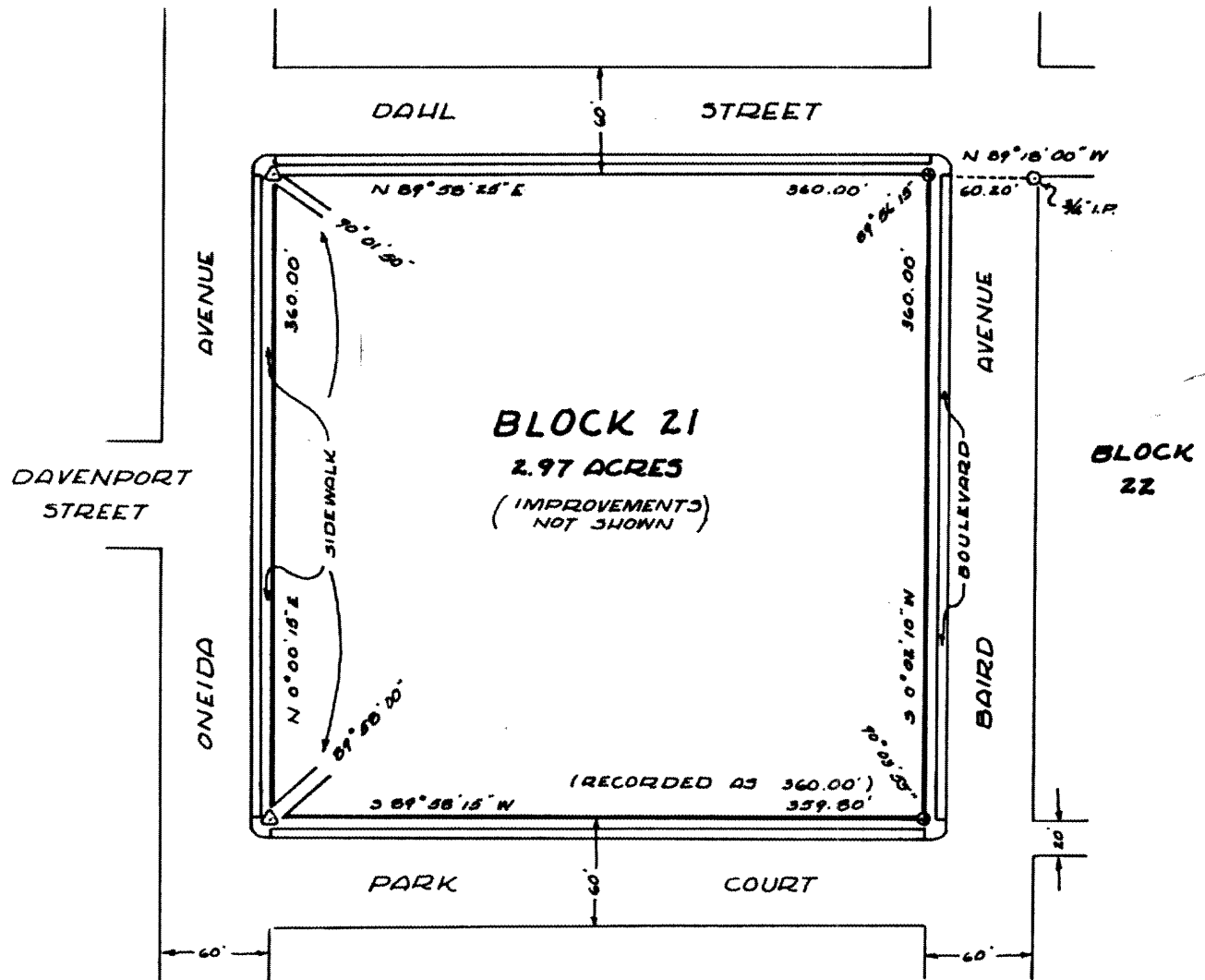
BLOCK 21, SECOND ADDITION TO THE CITY OF RHINELANDER, ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN
