## **ADDENDUM**

to existing information for the

## East quarter corner of Section 9, T. 35 N., R. 11 E. Oneida County, Wisconsin.

A Certified Land Corner Restoration form was prepared by Philip T. Hanson, RLS-498, on April 15, 1975 and was filed in the Oneida County Register of Deeds office on October 1st, 1975.

On 10/27/96, I visited the corner and found it to be as described on the above mentioned Corner Restoration form. For maintenance to the corner I:

Set a white vinyl sign post, 1' SSE of the corner monument;

- Set a 1" x 30" iron pipe on the section line running south and on the South right-of-way line of Stockley-Meister Road. Said pipe was set 46.85 feet from the corner monument. (see map of survey for John Sager);
- Set a 1 1/2" x 30" iron pipe 30.00 feet north of the corner monument. This pipe, the corner monument and the above mentioned 1" pipe form three points on a straight line;
- Set an aluminum nail in a low blaze on the right side of Hansons' red pine, NW, 16.42 feet, and I
- Set an aluminum nail in a low blaze on the right side of Hansons' white pine, NE, 10.63 feet.
