

A parcel of land in Gov't. Lot 5, Section 5 and the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4, Section 6, T36N, R10E, Pelican Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the one-quarter corner common to Sections 5 and 6, marked by a 1-1/4" iron pipe; thence N10°48.9'W, (solar bearing) 1138.22 feet along the west line of Section 5 to the place of beginning, a one-eighth corner, marked by a 2" iron pipe.

Thence S89°28.0'E, 622.81 feet along the north line of Gov't. Lot 5 to the meander corner near the westerly shore of Fourth Lake, marked by a 2" iron pipe; thence S35°29.5'W, 399.61 feet along the lake to a 2" iron pipe; thence N70°19.0'W, 663.54 feet to a 2" iron pipe; thence N10°48.9'W, 112 feet, more or less, to a point on the northerly line of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 5; thence easterly 255 feet, more or less, along said northerly line of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 6 to the place of beginning.

Subject to a 10 foot wide water line easement over the above described parcel of land to that parcel of land to the north.

Subject to easements for telephone and electrical power lines.  
Including also all lands lying between the meander line and the shore of Fourth Lake.

Said parcel of land contains 4.26 acres.
