Dear Steve:

Unless determined to the contrary by any future judgement of the courts, it is our present opinion that the east line of Section 16, Township 38 North, Range 7 East, as previously established by County Surveyor Maine in 1938, and subsequently retraced by Marvin Seymour, DNR Surveyor, in 1987, is the correct title boundary for the state owned lands in Govt. Lot 3, lying west of said established section line.

Therefore, we would have no title interest to or bona fide claim to any private lands lying in Govt. Lot 2 of Section 15 of said township and range, lying east of said established section line.

Said established section line by County Surveyor Maine, and retracement thereof by department survey, documents a boundary line by adverse possession which has been acquiesced by adjoining for the past 50 years at minimum and consequently any future action by yourself, or any other adjoining involving the acquisition, conveyancing or quieting of title to private lands lying east of said established section line or title line is not contrary to any land title interests of the state.
