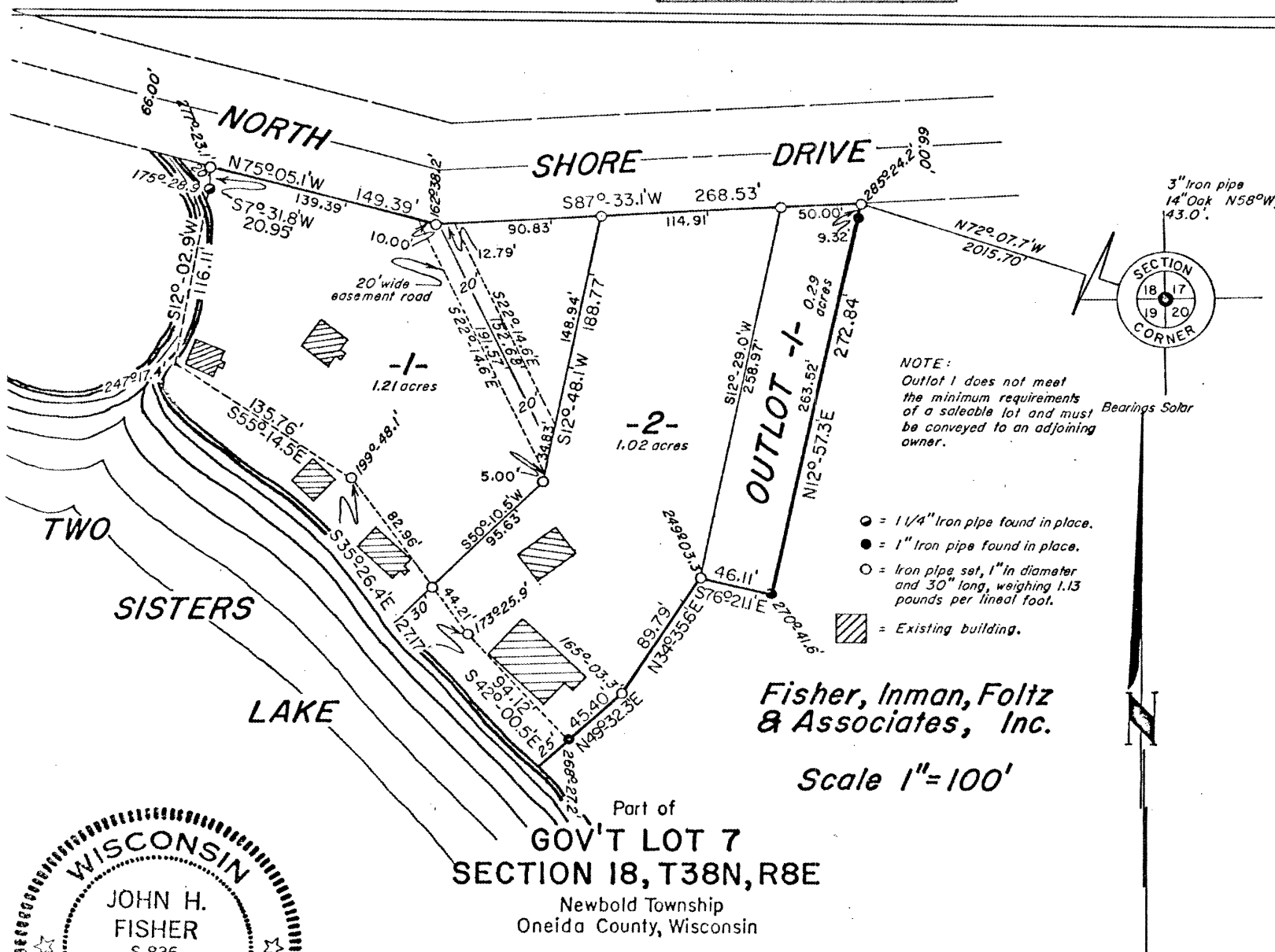

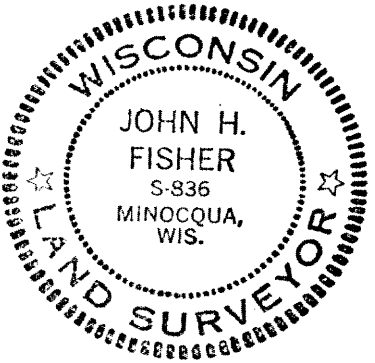

PARCELS 1 and 2 and Outlot 1, being part of Gov't. Lot 7, Section 18, T38N, R8E, Newbold Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:
 Commencing at the Section Corner common to Sections 17, 18, 19 and 20, marked by a 3" iron pipe, witnessed by a 14" Oak bearing N58°W, 43.0 feet; thence N72°-07.7'W, (solar bearing) 2015.70 feet to the place of beginning, marked by a 1" iron pipe on the southerly right-of-way line of North Shore Drive.
 Thence S87°-33.1'W, 268.53 feet along said southerly right-of-way line to a 1" iron pipe; thence N75°-05.1'W, 149.39 feet along said right-of-way line to a 1" iron pipe near the easterly bank of the Creek; thence meandering along the Creek S7°-31.8'W, 20.95 feet and S12°-02.9'W, 116.11 feet to a point where the easterly bank of said Creek intersects the northerly shore of Two Sisters Lake; thence meandering along the lake S55°-14.5'E, 135.76 feet; S35°-26.4'E, 127.17 feet and S42°-00.5'E, 94.12 feet to a 1" iron pipe; thence N49°-32.3'E, 45.40 feet to a 1" iron pipe; thence N34°-35.6'E, 89.79 feet to a 1" iron pipe; thence S76°-21.1'E, 46.11 feet to a 1" iron pipe; thence N12°-57.3'E, 272.84 feet to the place of beginning.

Including also all lands lying between the meander lines and the Creek and between the meander lines and the shore of Two Sisters Lake.
