

PARCELS 1, 2, 3 and 4, being part of Gov't Lot 5, Section 28, T39N, R9E, Sugar Camp Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the one-quarter corner common to Sections 28 and 33, witnessed by U.S. Cadastral Survey brass capped iron pipes bearing $N0^{\circ}-00.9'W$, 16.83 feet and $S0^{\circ}-00.9'E$, 16.50 feet; thence $N43^{\circ}-50.4'E$, (solar bearing) 1610.88 feet to the place of beginning, marked by a 2" iron pipe near the westerly shore of Chain Lake.

Thence S66°-44.5'W, 37.38 feet to a 2" iron pipe; thence S85°-42.6'W, 135.00 feet to a 2" iron pipe on the northeasterly right-of-way line of a Town Road; thence N59°-32.8'W, 385.00 feet along said right-of-way line to a 2" iron pipe; thence N25°-26.9'E, 179.93 feet to a 2" iron pipe near the westerly shore of Chain Lake; thence along the lake S58°-51.6'E, 140.00 feet to a 1" iron pipe; S58°-04.8'E, 134.00 feet to a 1" iron pipe; S55°-33.3'E, 100.99 feet to a 1" iron pipe and S38°-52.1'E, 170.00 feet to the place of beginning.

Including also all lands lying between the meaning lines and the store of Chain Lake.
