Island Number One, or Boulder Island, whose dimensions are approximately 250 feet N-S and 110 feet E-W; said island rises 8 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.50 acre, more or less. Island Number One lies in the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 39 North, Range 4 East, and near the western shore of Squaw Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 2.)
7. Island Number Two, or South Island, whose dimensions are approximately 120 feet N-S and 120 feet E-W; said island rises 4 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.30 acre, more or less. Island Number Two lies in the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 16, Township 39 North, Range 4 East, and near the western shore of Squaw Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 2.)
8. Island Number One, or Faun Island, whose dimensions are approximately 330 feet N-S and 300 feet E-W; said island rises 30 feet more or less above the water and contains 1.30 acres, more or less. Island Number One lies in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 36, Township 39 North, Range 4 East, and near the eastern shore of Pine Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 3.)
9. Bulrush Island, whose dimensions are approximately 60 feet NW-SE and 190 feet NE-SW; said island rises 8 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.25 acre, more or less. Bulrush Island lies in the E 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 38 North, Range 4 East, and near the northeastern shore of Swamsauger Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 4.)
10. Three Pine Island, whose dimensions are approximately 135 feet N-S and 210 feet E-W; said island rises 8 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.55 acre, more or less. Three Pine Island lies in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 38 North, Range 4 East, and near the northeastern shore of Swamsauger Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 4.)
11. Island Number One, or Scotty's Island, whose dimensions are approximately 665 feet N-S and 680 feet E-W; said island rises 25 feet more or less above the water and contains 6.40 acres, more or less. Island Number One lies partly in the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 2, Township 39 North, Range 5 East, partly in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 3, Township 39 North, Range 5 East, and in the southwest one-quarter of Shisebogama Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 5.)
12. Ivy Island, whose dimensions are approximately 50 feet N-S and 100 feet E-W; said island rises 3 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.10 acre, more or less. Ivy Island lies in the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 39 North, Range 5 East, and near the western shore of Squirrel Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 6.)
13. Lone Rock Island, whose dimensions are approximately 15 feet N-S and 10 feet E-W; said island rises 3 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.003 acre, more or less. Lone Rock Island lies in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 39 North, Range 5 East, and near the eastern shore of Squirrel Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 6.)

14. North Island, whose dimensions are approximately 185 feet N-S and 230 feet E-W; said island rises 10 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.75 acre, more or less. North Island lies in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 39 North, Range 5 East, and in the northernmost part of Squirrel Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 6.)
15. Island Number One, or Pine Island, whose dimensions are approximately 460 feet N-S and 300 feet E-W; said island rises 25 feet more or less above the water and contains 1.75 acres, more or less. Island Number One lies in the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 39 North, Range 5 East, and near the western shore of Mercer Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 8.)
16. Island Number Two, or Poplar Island, whose dimensions are approximately 300 feet N-S and 365 feet E-W; said island rises 15 feet more or less above the water and contains 1.70 acres, more or less. Island Number Two lies partly in the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 39 North, Range 5 East, partly in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 39 North, Range 5 East, and near the southern shore of Mercer Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 8.)
17. Bear Island, whose dimensions are approximately 560 feet NW-SE and 325 feet NE-SW; said island rises 10 feet more or less above the water and contains 2.60 acres, more or less. Bear Island lies in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 16, Township 39 North, Range 5 East, and near the northwestern shore of Franklin Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 9.)
18. Spruce Island, whose dimensions are approximately 100 feet N-S and 80 feet E-W; said island rises 2 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.20 acre, more or less. Spruce Island lies in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 16, Township 39 North, Range 5 East, and near the northwestern shore of Franklin Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 9.)
19. Cub Island, whose dimensions are approximately 180 feet N-S and 160 feet E-W; said island rises 6 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.40 acre, more or less. Cub Island lies in the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 24, Township 38 North, Range 5 East, and near the northeastern shore of Bear Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 10.)
20. McDonald Island, whose dimensions are approximately 150 feet N-S and 200 feet E-W; said island rises 15 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.50 acre, more or less. McDonald Island lies in the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 3, Township 36 North, Range 5 East, and near the southeastern shore of Burrows Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 11.)
21. Norway Island, whose dimensions are approximately 200 feet NW-SE and 160 feet NE-SW; said island rises 10 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.45 acre, more or less. Norway Island lies in the E 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Section 16, Township 39 North, Range 6 East, and in the southern one-half of Kawaguesaga Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 13.)

22. 6 Pine Island, whose dimensions are approximately 75 feet N-S and 60 feet E-W; said island lies 3 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.10 acre, more or less. 6 Pine Island lies in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 38 North, Range 6 East, and in the eastern one-half of Lake Katherine, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 14.)
23. Muskeg Island, whose dimensions are approximately 30 feet N-S and 30 feet E-W; said island rises 1 foot more or less above the water and contains 0.02 acre, more or less. Muskeg Island lies in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 38 North, Range 6 East, and near the eastern shore of Lake Seventeen, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 15.)
24. Island Number One, whose dimensions are approximately 35 feet NW-SE and 130 feet NE-SW; said island rises 5 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.15 acre, more or less. Island Number One lies in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 17, Township 38 North, Range 6 East, and in the southeastern one-quarter of Lake Seventeen, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 15.)
25. Island Number Two, whose dimensions are approximately 130 feet NW-SE and 100 feet NE-SW; said island rises 6 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.35 acre, more or less. Island Number Two lies in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 17, Township 38 North, Range 6 East, and in the southeastern one-quarter of Lake Seventeen, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 15.)
26. Island Number One, whose dimensions are approximately 240 feet N-S and 475 feet E-W; said island rises 17 feet more or less above the water and contains 1.35 acres, more or less. Island Number One lies partly in the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 37 North, Range 6 East, partly in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 37 North, Range 6 East, and in the eastern one-half of Little Bearskin Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 16.)
27. Island Number Two, whose dimensions are approximately 400 feet NW-SE and 100 feet NE-SW; said island rises 10 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.70 acre, more or less. Island Number Two lies in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 37 North, Range 6 East, and in the eastern one-half of Little Bearskin Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 16.)
28. Island Number Three, whose dimensions are approximately 150 feet N-S and 340 feet E-W; said island rises 9 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.85 acre, more or less. Island Number Three lies in the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 37 North, Range 6 East, and in the southwestern one-quarter of Little Bearskin Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 16.)
29. Spruce Island, or Island Number One, whose dimensions are approximately 120 feet N-S and 120 feet E-W; said island rises 8 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.25 acre, more or less. Spruce Island lies partly in the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 37 North, Range 6 East, partly in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 37 North, Range 6 East, and near the eastern shore of Currie Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 17.)

30. Pine Island, or Island Number Two, whose dimensions are approximately 265 feet N-S and 100 feet E-W; said island rises 9 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.50 acre, more or less. Pine Island lies in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 37 North, Range 6 East, and in the southern one-half of Currie Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 17.)
31. Balsam Island, whose dimensions are approximately 150 feet NW-SE and 265 feet NE-SW; said island rises 7 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.80 acre, more or less. Balsam Island lies partly in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 39 North, Range 7 East, partly in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 8, Township 39 North, Range 7 East, and in the southwestern one-quarter of Carrol Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 18.)
32. West Island, whose dimensions are approximately 340 feet NW-SE and 400 feet NE-SW; said island rises 10 feet more or less above the water and contains 1.85 acres, more or less. West Island lies partly in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 39 North, Range 7 East, partly in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 8, Township 39 North, Range 7 East, and in the southwest one-quarter of Carrol Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 18.)
33. Oak Island, whose dimensions are approximately 275 feet N-S and 175 feet E-W; said island rises 10 feet more or less above the water and contains 1.00 acre, more or less. Oak Island lies partly in the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 4, Township 39 North, Range 7 East, partly in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 39 North, Range 7 East, and in the western one-half of Carrol Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 18.)
34. Turtle Island, whose dimensions are approximately 725 feet N-S and 265 feet E-W; said island rises 30 feet more or less above the water and contains 3.00 acres, more or less. Turtle Island lies in the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 39 North, Range 7 East, and in the eastern one-half of Carrol Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 18.)
35. Farm Island, whose dimensions are approximately 475 feet NW-SE and 265 feet E-W; said island rises 25 feet more or less above the water and contains 2.70 acres, more or less. Farm Island lies in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 39 North, Range 7 East, and near the western shore of Madeline Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 19.)
36. Spruce Island, or Jacobs Island, whose dimensions are approximately 120 feet N-S and 90 feet E-W; said island rises 15 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.20 acre, more or less. Spruce Island lies in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 39 North, Range 7 East, and in the northwestern one-quarter of Buffalo Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 20.)

37. Cabin Island, or White Birch Island, whose dimensions are approximately 265 feet NW-SE and 430 feet NE-SW; said island rises 8 feet more or less above the water and contains 2.30 acres, more or less. Cabin Island lies in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 39 North, Range 7 East, and near the middle of Sweeney Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 21.)
38. Knob Island, whose dimensions are approximately 175 feet N-S and 175 feet E-W; said island rises 9 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.45 acre, more or less. 39. Balsam Island, whose dimensions are approximately 65 feet NW-SE and 40 feet NE-SW; said island rises 6 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.06 acre, more or less. Balsam Island lies in the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 38 North, Range 7 East, and in the southeastern one-quarter of Tomahawk Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 24.)
40. Crescent Island, whose dimensions are approximately 35 feet NW-SE and 725 feet NE-SW; said island rises 5 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.25 acre, more or less. Crescent Island lies in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 38 North, Range 7 East, and in the southeastern one-quarter of Tomahawk Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 24.)
41. Dead Pine Island, whose dimensions are approximately 40 feet N-S and 20 feet E-W; said island rises 2 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.02 acre, more or less. Dead Pine Island lies in the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 38 North, Range 7 East, and in the southeastern one-quarter of Tomahawk Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 24.)
42. High Island, whose dimensions are approximately 330 feet N-S and 550 feet E-W; said island rises 30 feet more or less above the water and contains 2.50 acres, more or less. High Island lies in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 38 North, Range 7 East, and in the southeastern one-quarter of Tomahawk Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 24.)
43. Hughston Island, whose dimensions are approximately 300 feet N-S and 165 feet E-W; said island rises 6 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.80 acre, more or less. Hughston Island lies in the E 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 38 North, Range 7 East, and in the southeastern one-quarter of Tomahawk Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 24.)
44. Island Number Two, or South Island, whose dimensions are approximately 115 feet NW-SE and 100 feet NE-SW; said island rises 4 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.25 acre, more or less. Island Number Two lies in the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 16, Township 38 North, Range 7 East, and near the western shore of South Two Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 26.)

45. Seed Island, whose dimensions are approximately 85 feet N-S and 100 feet E-W; said island rises 4 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.07 acre, more or less. Seed Island lies in the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 32, Township 38 North, Range 7 East, and in the northeastern one-quarter of Seed Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 29.)
46. Lone Island, whose dimensions are approximately 130 feet N-S and 100 feet E-W; said island rises 7 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.25 acre, more or less. Lone Island lies partly in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 33, Township 38 North, Range 7 East; partly in the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 33, Township 38 North, Range 7 East; and in the northern one-half of Lumen Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 30.)
47. White Birch Island, whose dimensions are approximately 100 feet N-S and 140 feet E-W; said island rises 2 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.20 acre, more or less. White Birch Island lies in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 37 North, Range 7 East, and near the western shore of Alva Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 31.)
48. Squirrel Island, whose dimensions are approximately 140 feet N-S and 135 feet E-W; said island rises 9 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.50 acre, more or less. Squirrel Island lies partly in the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 37 North, Range 7 East; partly in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 24, Township 37 North, Range 7 East; and in the eastern one-half of Maud Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 32.)
49. Muskrat Island, whose dimensions are approximately 200 feet N-S and 200 feet E-W; said island rises 6 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.65 acre, more or less. Muskrat Island lies in the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 24, Township 37 North, Range 7 East, and in the western one-half of Maud Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 32.)
50. Three Stumps Island, whose dimensions are approximately 40 feet N-S and 50 feet E-W; said island rises 4 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.07 acre, more or less. Three Stumps Island lies in the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 4, Township 36 North, Range 7 East, and in the eastern one-half of Oneida Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 33.)
51. Fournier's Island, whose dimensions are approximately 475 feet NW-SE and 265 feet NE-SW; said island rises 25 feet more or less above the water and contains 1.85 acres, more or less. Fournier's Island lies partly in the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 4, Township 36 North, Range 7 East; partly in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 36 North, Range 7 East; partly in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 8, Township 36 North, Range 7 East; and near the southwestern shore of Oneida Lake, Oneida County. Pine Island lies in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 16, Township 38 North, Range 8 East, and in the northwestern one-half of Brown Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 37.)
57. South Island, whose dimensions are approximately 135 feet NW-SE and 225 feet NE-SW; said island rises 5 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.65 acre, more or less. South Island lies in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 16, Township 38 North, Range 8 East, and near the southwestern shore of Brown Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 37.)
58. Ellis Island, whose dimensions are approximately 725 feet N-S and 400 feet E-W; said island rises 11 feet more or less above the water and contains 4.75 acres, more or less. Ellis Island lies in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 19, Township 38 North, Range 8 East, and near the northern shore of the western body of Two Sisters Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 38.)
59. Coon Island, whose dimensions are approximately 120 feet N-S and 75 feet E-W; said island rises 5 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.15 acre, more or less. Coon Island lies in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 19, Township 37 North, Range 8 East, and near the northeastern shore of Coon Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 40.)

60. Shack Island, whose dimensions are approximately 125 feet N-S and 100 feet E-W; said island rises 15 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.30 acre, more or less. Shack Island lies in the N 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Section 28, Township 37 North, Range 8 East, and in the northern one-quarter of Flannery Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 42.)
61. Lone Pine Island, whose dimensions are approximately 50 feet N-S and 15 feet E-W; said island rises 2 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.02 acre, more or less. Lone Pine Island lies in the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 28, Township 37 North, Range 8 East, and near the western shore of Flannery Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 42.)
62. Brush Island, whose dimensions are approximately 65 feet N-S and 30 feet E-W; said island rises 3 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.03 acre, more or less. Brush Island lies in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 33, Township 37 North, Range 8 East, and near the western shore of Flannery Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 42.)
63. Campfire Island, whose dimensions are approximately 100 feet NW-SE and 200 feet NE-SW; said island rises 3 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.35 acre, more or less. Campfire Island lies in the N 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Section 17, Township 36 North, Range 8 East, and in the northwestern one-quarter of Crescent Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 44.)
64. Pine Island, whose dimensions are approximately 140 feet NW-SE and 275 feet NE-SW; said island rises 6 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.80 acre, more or less. Pine Island lies in the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 21, Township 36 North, Range 8 East, and in the southwestern one-quarter of Emma Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 45.)
65. Pine Island, whose dimensions are approximately 230 feet N-S and 125 feet E-W; said island rises 10 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.65 acre, more or less. Pine Island lies in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 36 North, Range 8 East, and in the northern one-quarter of Lake Julia, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 46.)
66. Tamarack Island, whose dimensions are approximately 100 feet N-S and 40 feet E-W; said island rises 3 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.08 acre, more or less. Tamarack Island lies in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 36 North, Range 8 East, and near the western shore of Lake Julia, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 46.)
67. Squash Island, whose dimensions are approximately 560 feet N-S and 500 feet E-W; said island rises 10 feet more or less above the water and contains 3.20 acres, more or less. Squash Island lies partly in the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 1, Township 38 North, Range 9 East; partly in the W 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 38 North, Range 9 East; and in the western one-quarter of Indian Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 47.)

68. Balsam Island, whose dimensions are approximately 185 feet N-S and 200 feet E-W; said island rises 6 feet more or less above the water and contains 0.50 acre, more or less. Balsam Island lies in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 38 North, Range 9 East, and in the western one-quarter of Indian Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 47.)
69. Point Island, whose dimensions are approximately 300 feet N-S and 230 feet E-W; said island rises 12 feet more or less above the water and contains 1.10 acres, more or less. Point Island lies in the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 38 North, Range 9 East, and near a peninsula of the southern shore of Indian Lake, Oneida County. (See attached Map No. 47.)
