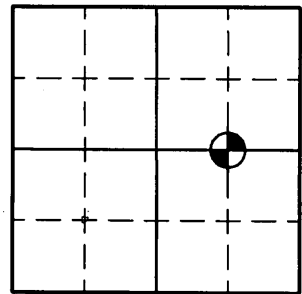

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Describe what was found, its location and origin. May 7, 2008 - Prior to road construction we were hired to preserve the location of the Southwest corner of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 lying near the centerline of Cedar Falls Road but, the road had already been ground up and graded the day before. We dug down about 1 foot and found a 1-1/4" iron pipe. This corner is shown as an iron pipe on Plat of Survey by L.W. Scott, dated 8/17/1963 - Oneida County Land Information Office Map Number B-6100 and a found 1-1/4" iron pipe on "The Woods" County Plat by John Fisher, dated 9/3/1974.

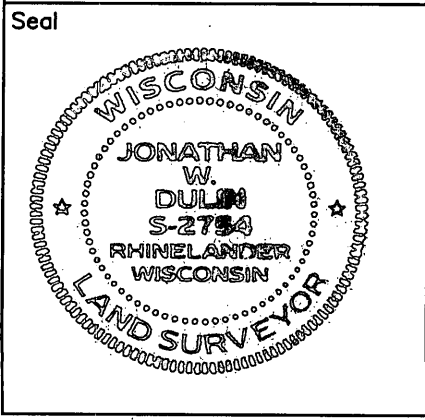
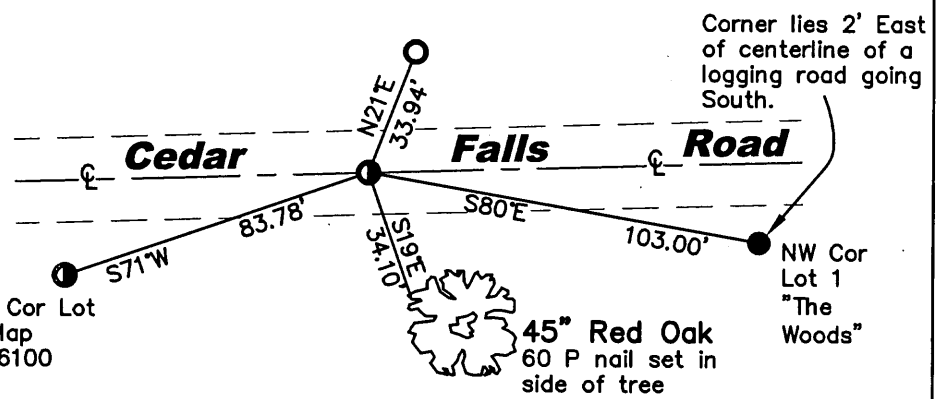
