

Notes:

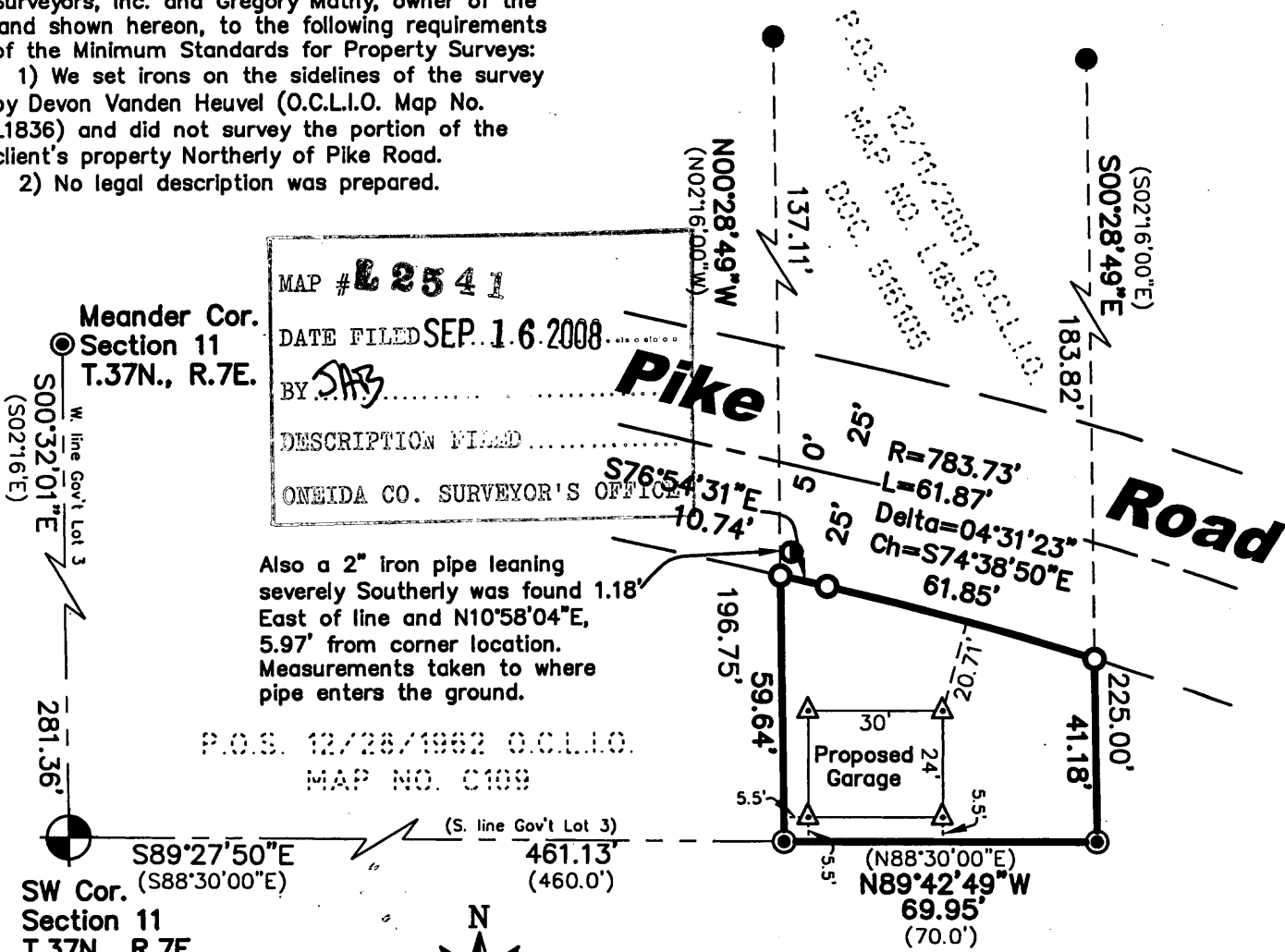
1. The right-of-way width of 50 feet for Pike Road was based on information provided by the Town of Lake Tomahawk and verified on the WisDOT Wisconsin Information System for Local Roads (WISLR) website by Oneida County staff. The Southerly R/W was set at 25' from the existing centerline.

2. Per Chapter AE-7 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code a waiver has been agreed to between Matthew E. Hogle, S#1910 of Nicolet Surveyors, Inc. and Gregory Mathy, owner of the land shown hereon, to the following requirements of the Minimum Standards for Property Surveys:

- 1) We set irons on the sidelines of the survey by Devon Vanden Heuvel (O.C.L.I.O. Map No. L1836) and did not survey the portion of the client's property Northerly of Pike Road.
- 2) No legal description was prepared.

Part of Government Lot 3 of Section 11, T.37N., R.7E., Town of Lake Tomahawk, Oneida County, Wisconsin

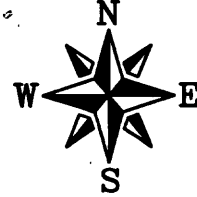

Also a 2" iron pipe leaning severely Southerly was found 1.18' East of line and N10°58'04"E, 5.97' from corner location. Measurements taken to where pipe enters the ground.

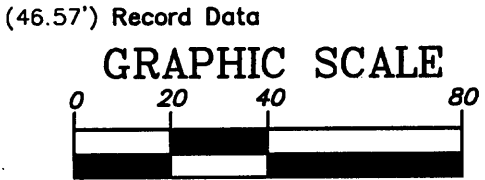
