PETITION

GENTLEMEN:

The Petition of Harvey G. Goegeline and Bernice M. Goegeline, his wife, respectfully shows as follows:

1. That they are the joint owners of the following described real estate situated in the Town of Schoepke, County of Oneida and State of Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows, to wit:

A parcel of land in Government Lot numbered Five (5), Section numbered Thirteen (13), Township numbered Thirty-five(35) North of Range numbered Ten (10) East, described as follows: COMMENCING at an oak stake Two Hundred (200) feet southerly from an old one-eighth (1/8th) post, said one-eighth (1/8th) post being the northeast corner of Government Lot numbered One (1), Section numbered Fourteen (14) said town and range; thence easterly to an oak post onthe bank of Pelican Lake, 200 feet southwesterly from an old post and square iron, said old postbeing on a line projected across Government Lot numbered Five (5), Section numbered Thirteen (13) said Town and Range from the northerly boundary of said Government Lot numbered One(1) to Pelican Lake; thence southwesterly along the shoreline of Pelican Lake, One Hundred (100) feet to an Oak Post; thence westerly to an oak post on easterly boundary of a public road 300 feet southerly from said one-eighth (1/8th)post; thence northerly 100 feet to an Oak post and point of beginning.

2. That as your Petitioners are informed and believe, the Town Board in ots official capacity has constructed established and is maintaining a dedicated road in the aforesaid Town of Schoepke for the use and enjoyment of the general public commencing at a point 175 feet West of the Clarence Bodenhagen house on the North line of Govt. Lot numbered Five(5), Section numbered Thirteen (13), Township numbered Thirty-five(35), Range numbered Ten (10) east; thence in a Southerly direction along lake shoreto the South line of said Govt. Lot numbered Five(5) a distance of approximately 1100 feet, said Highway to be 3 rods wide.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioners pray that the Town Board of Schoepke extend the aforesaid road 50 feet further to the North line of aforesaid property.
