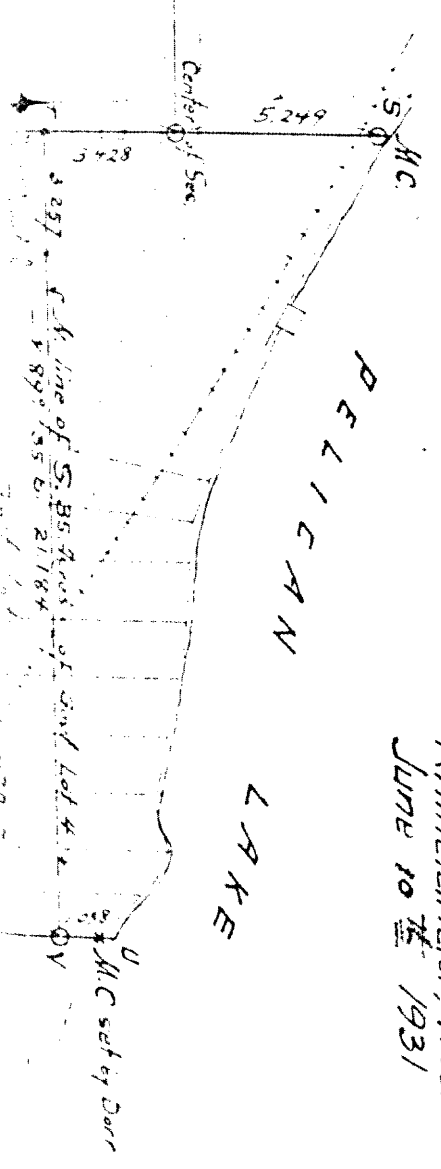

Surveyor's Certificate

I, Harry C. Hall, do hereby certify: That in May, 1931, in surveying Dnt. Lot 4 Sec. 26-35-10 E. for C.R. Guth's Unrecorded Plat, I retraced the original west line of the section and the original south line of the section and accepted the east line of the section as run by B. F. Dorr in 1901, I also accepted Dorr's 1/8 sec. line between Dnt. Lots 4-5 which forms the west line of Pelican South Shore Resorts Plat (Recorded in 1908 in Vol. 3 Plats, Page 9); For an intermediate west line of Sec. 26 I took the mean between the course of the west line of the SW Quarter and the course direct from the SW corner to the MC. For the N+S quarter section line I ran on a course intermediate between the east line and the aforementioned mean west line, I ran the SW quarter sec. line parallel to a latitudinal line drawn thru the SE + SW corners of the section; That the map hereon drawn correctly represents my Survey of Sec. 26 in chains and decimals thereof and the manner in which the corners were marked and perpetuated.

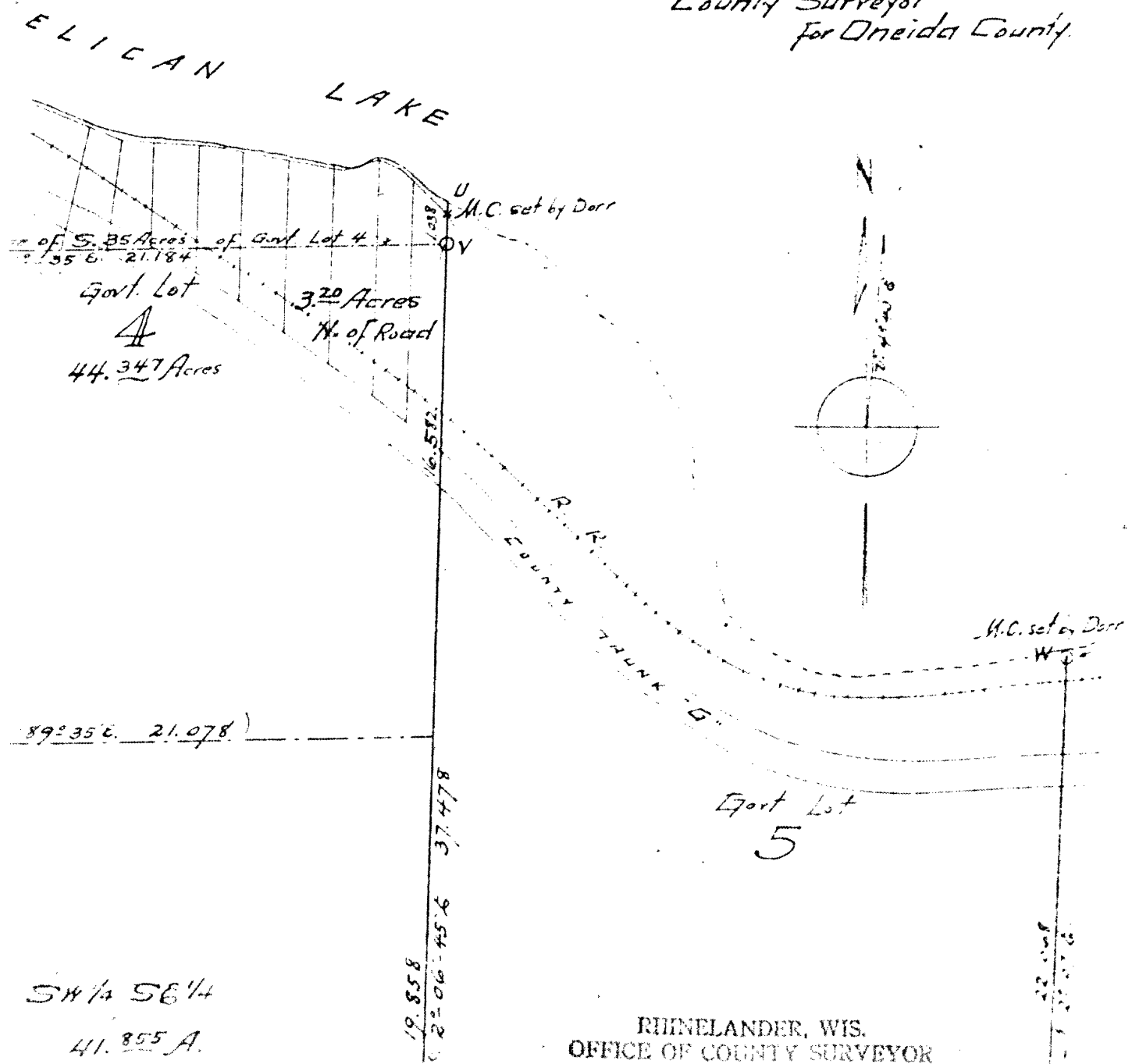

Guth's Unrecorded I traced the original west line of the section and the original east line of the section and accepted the east line of the section as shown on Dorr in 1901; I also accepted Dorr's 1/8 sec. line between 4 & 5 which forms the west line of Pelican South Shore (Recorded in 1908 in Vol. 3 Plats, Page 9); For an east line of Sec. 26 I took the mean between the course of the SW Quarter and the course direct from the SW M.C. For the N + S quarter section line I ran on a course between the east line and the aforementioned mean west line of the E + W quarter-sec. line parallel to a latitudinal line drawn between the N + S corners of the section; That the map hereon drawn correctly represents my survey of Sec. 26 in chains and decimals thereof and the manner in which the corners were marked and perpetuated.
