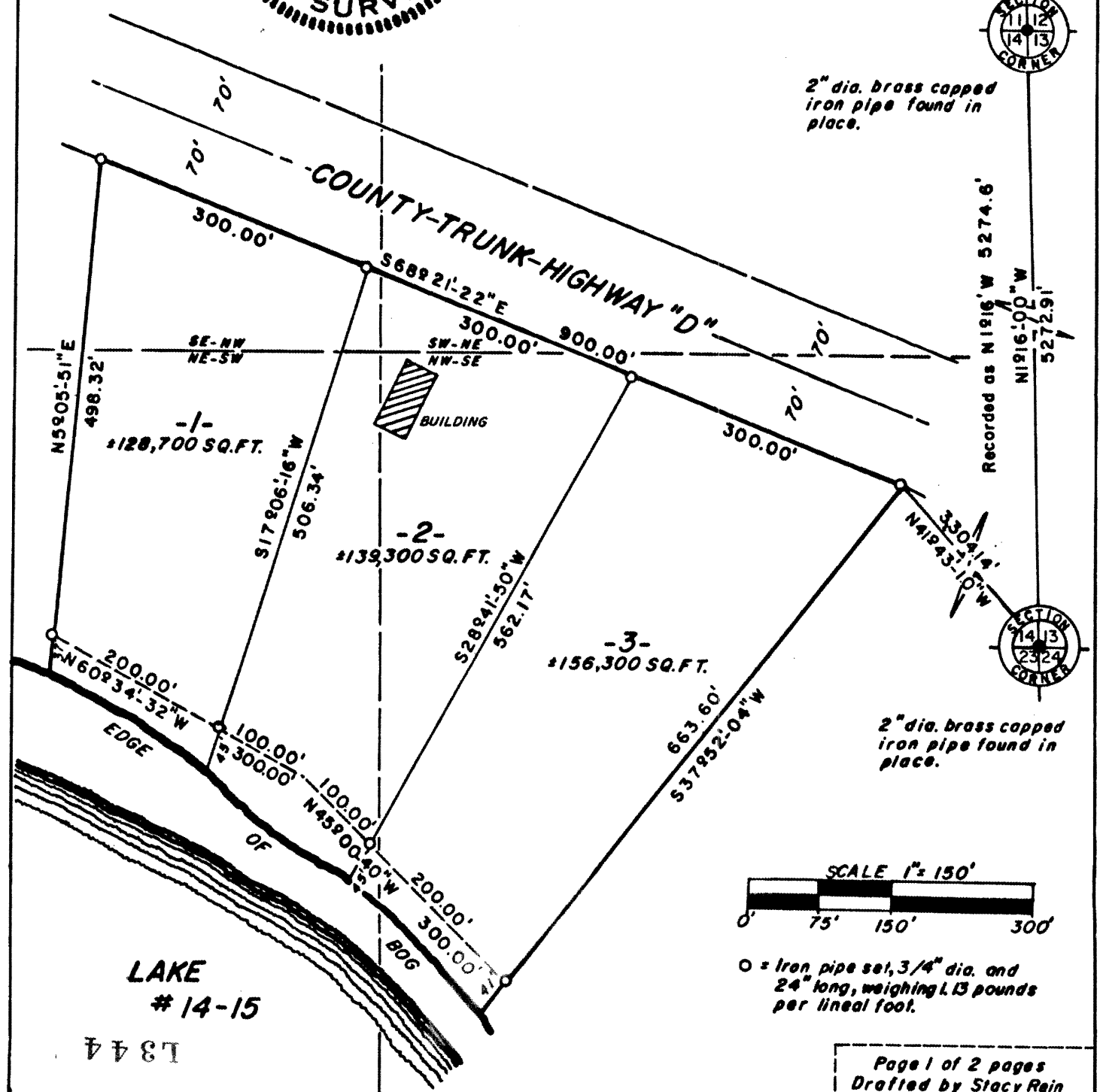

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, JEROME N. KRAEMER, Registered Land Surveyor No. S-1448, hereby certify that by the direction of EDWIN W. HUNTER, I have surveyed and mapped Lots 1, 2 and 3, which are represented by this Certified Survey Map; that the exterior boundary of the parcel of land surveyed and mapped is described as follows:

Lots 1, 2 and 3 being part of the Southwest one-quarter of the Northeast one-half, Southeast one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter, Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter and Northwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SW-1/4 NE 1/2, SE-1/4 NW-1/4, NE-1/4 SW-1/4, NW-1/4 SE-1/4) of Section 14, T38N, R6E, Hazelhurst Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of Section 14, marked by a 2" diameter brass-capped iron pipe; thence $N41^{\circ}-43'-10''W$, 3,304.14 feet to the place of beginning marked by an iron pipe.

Thence $S37^{\circ}-52'-04''W$, 663.60 feet to an iron pipe near the northerly shore of Lake #14-15; thence meandering along the shore of Lake #14-15 $N45^{\circ}-00'-40''W$, 300.00 feet and $N60^{\circ}-34'-32''W$, 300.00 feet to an iron pipe; thence $N5^{\circ}-05'-51''E$, 498.32 feet to an iron pipe; thence $S68^{\circ}-21'-22''E$, 900.00 feet to the place of beginning.

Including also all lands lying between the meander line and the shore of Lake #14-15.

That this Certified Survey Map is a correct representation of the exterior boundary surveyed and described; that I have fully complied with the provisions of Chapter 236.34 of the Wisconsin Statutes and the provisions of the Oneida County Zoning and Shorelands Protection Ordinance in surveying and mapping same.
