Dear Sir

Have just returned 16.37.13-E.

I am enclosing copy of Govt. filed of Sec. 27.35-10 as requested. I have not done any work in this section. Last May the Chairman of the Town asked me to come and plat a cemetery in this section, but I was very busy and sent my son to do the work. I have talked with my son in regard to this work and find the deed given by your man Schaeneck calls for 208 feet square in the NE corner of NW. SW. Mr Schaeneck had measured out this piece and the town had cleared it ready for platting. My son told them it would be necessary to run the  $\frac{1}{4}$  lines and establish the  $\frac{1}{8}$  P. West of center. This they did and found the land which they had prepared was not the land deeded to the town.

There is a road which was supposed to be on the E+W  $\frac{1}{4}$  line, but my son tells me it north of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  line quite a little. After my son had run the  $\frac{1}{4}$  lines he set the center of the section but Mr Keeler

(the chairman) had him drive the post level or little below the surface, and requested <sup>him</sup> not mark up any bearing and the same thing happened at the 1/8 P. west of the center. It seems the line runs through Mr Schoeneck's field and he is not getting <sup>all</sup> the land he had fenced in. The town has fenced it. They gave Mr Schoeneck notice to mow his fence, which he refused to do and I am told the town mowed it for him. I think this gives you an idea of what the trouble is.

Mr Schoeneck's deed of NW SW reserves 50 links on north ~~side~~ side for road. Mr Keeler the chairman owns SW NW and his deed calls for a reservation of two rods wide on south side. The records show the road is on the 1/4 line, and it is not there. The deed given by Mr Schoeneck to the <sup>town</sup> calls for land lying south of the road. In other words they are to have 208 feet square ~~exclusion~~ exclusion of road so the 1/8 P my son set would be 50 links north of cemetery grounds which are fenced in and which I have promised to plat in the spring trusting the information given will be of service to you. know when you could come

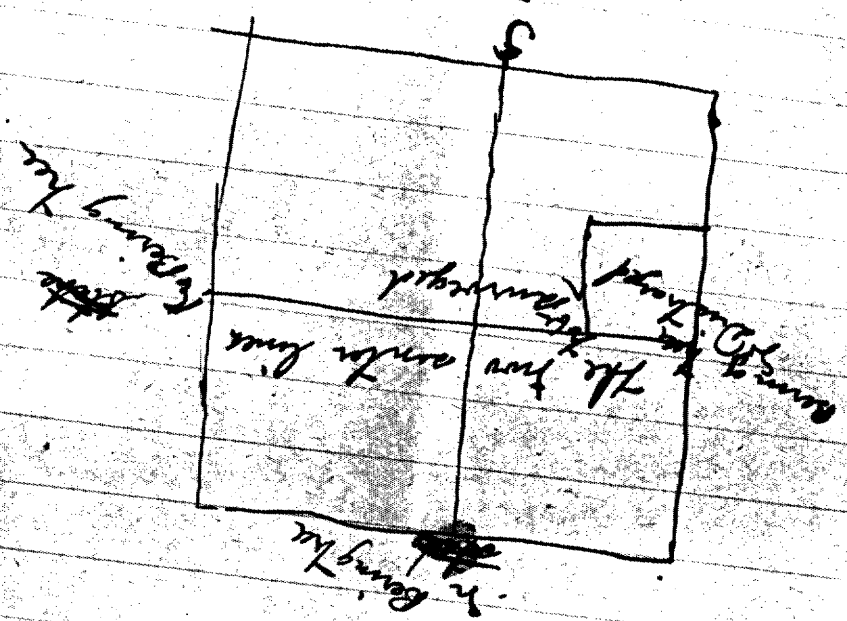
