

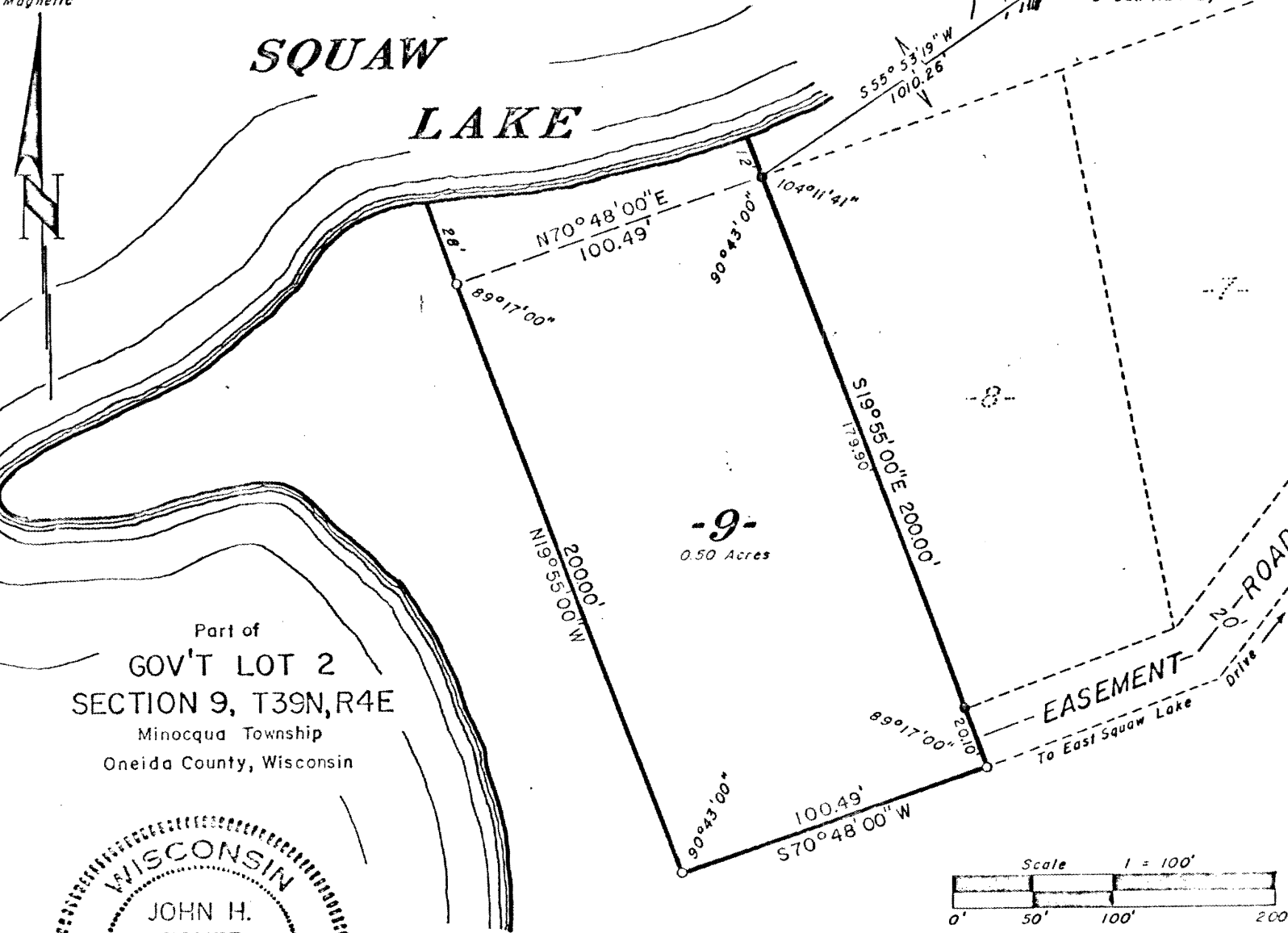

SQUAW LAKE

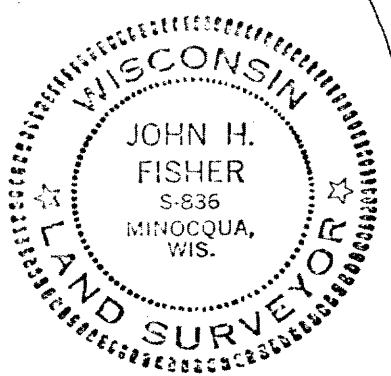
MEANDER CORNER

 8" Oak N24°E, 23.0'



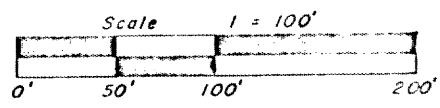

Parcel 9, being a parcel of land in Gov't Lot 2, Section 9, T39N, R4E, Minocqua Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the meander corner where the North line of Section 9 intersects the easterly shore of Squaw Lake, marked by an iron pipe; thence S55°53'19"W, 1010.26 feet to the place of beginning, marked by an iron pipe near the easterly shore of Squaw Lake.

Thence S19°55'00"E, 200.00 feet to a 1" iron pipe; thence S70°48'00"W, 100.49 feet to a 1" iron pipe; thence N19°55'00"W, 200.00 feet to a 1" iron pipe near the easterly shore of Squaw Lake; thence along the lake N70°48'00"E, 100.49 feet to the place of beginning.

Including also all lands lying between the meander lines and the shore of Squaw Lake.
