



STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN
MILEAGE OF LOCAL ROADS AND STREETS

The Wisconsin Highway Commission,
Gentlemen:

The undersigned, representing the Town of Little Rice
Oneida County, Wisconsin, do hereby certify that the mileage
of roads and streets, in the said Town entirely eligible to be
counted in determining the amount to be allotted to the said Town,
under the provisions of Subsection (8) of Section 20.49 of the Statutes
and due January 1, 1927, bears the following relation to mileage shown
on the plat filed in 1925 as required by that subsection.

1. The following described roads or streets have been discontinued and are no longer used for travel:

2. The following described roads and streets, in addition to those on which the 1926 allotment was made, have been opened and are now used for travel:

Starting at the N. E. corner of Sec. 11, 37-5-
running west (1/2) one 1/2 mile half ... Sec. 10 (1/2) one half
