With reference to your letter of December 9, 1953, regarding new roads for the year 1953, the following designated roads as indicated on enclosed marked Town Map, in red are presently in existence.

All such roads are of 4 rods width, with the exception of road marked 0, which has easements for 80 ft. width.

Roads A, B, C, and D, have been acquired and dedicated as Town Roads as per Statute No. 80.01. Roads E, F, and G, have been acquired and dedicated as Town Roads as per Statute No. 80.02.

As you most likely know, road X will be a County Trunk Road as of January 1, 1954.

I believe that this meets with the requirements of your letter of December 9, 1953.
