The following steps are the instructions for using the tract index books and finding documents.

1. First you will need to go to the county's home page (www.co.oneida.wi.us). Clink on the link for GIS/Maps:




2. Click on the Oneida County Manual Tract Index Pre 1997 link highlighted below:

- 3. You can search the tract indexes by **Township and Range** or by **Subdivision/Condo**.

The following Example will show how to search by <u>Township & Range</u>
For a parcel located in the NW ¼ of the NE ¼ in Section 25, Township 37 North, Range 7 East.


4. Use the drop down to select 37 for Township and 7 for the Range and then click on "Find All Records"



5. Then click on the link to download the <u>37-7.pdf</u>: This will take a few moments to load.




6. Scroll down the tract book pages until you find <u>Section 25</u>, as shown below;



7. Then you will go to the Quarter-quarter or Government Lot that you are searching:


- 8. This Example is located in the NW ¼ of the NE ¼. An enlarged version below shows how each document appears in the index book.
- 9. Each line item entry shows the <u>Volume</u>, <u>Record</u> and <u>Page</u> information. The example below shows 313 D 551, which means; Volume 313, Record D, Page 551
- 10. The "Record" is the type of Document. Here are some examples; "D" is Deeds, "M" is Mortgage, "S" or "Sat" is Satisfaction, "PR" is Partial Release, "Mis" or "Misc" is Miscellaneous, "E" is Easement, "Min" is Mineral, "LC" is Land Contract, "P" is Patent, "LP" is Lis Pendens



- 11. The tract index will show the Volume, Record and Page for all documents that have been indexed to the NWNE in 25-37-7. The oldest document will be the first entry on the first line then moving from left to right across the line. The most current document will be the last entry located at the end of the tract and you will need work backwards (from right to left) and across the page within the same line.
- 12. The current electronic tract index back to 1997 can be found online by accessing and using RecordEASE. Instructions to access that system are below. Please understand that you will find all documents that have been recorded and indexed for the entire Quarter-quarter or Government Lot within each tract. You are viewing everything recorded for the NW ¼ NE ¼ in Section 25, Township 37 Range 7, so it will include more parcels than just the one you are looking for.

The following is an Example of how to search for a Subdivision or Condominium

1. Enter the first few letters of the subdivision or condo, or, leave this section blank and click "Find By Subdivision/Condo" to see the entire list. The following Example is located in; Lot 1, in Block A, of Sylvan Shores Subdivision



2. After the results show, click on the Sylvan Shores.pdf file. This may take a few moments to load.

File: sylvan



3. Scroll to the Block and/or Lot for a subdivision, or Unit number for a condo. Each entry will show the Volume, Record and Page information.

Once you have identified the Volume and pages, you will need to set up an account for our online records system, RecordEASE in order to preview and purchase documents:




- 4. You will receive an email with the link to log into the system. You will need to log in using the user name and password you just created. Then you will need to enter your credit card information.
- 5. At the home screen, click on "Search":

6. You will have several options that you can use to search. Since you have the tract book, you will be searching by Book and Page, this is where you will need to enter the Volume/Book # and page # and click on "Search":



- 7. You will be able to preview the document by clicking "View Image". The image will appear, with a "Not Valid" watermark.
- 8. If you'd like to purchase a clean copy without the watermark, click on the "<u>Download Image</u>" button, select the pages you need and it will be charged to your credit card. The document will load as a pdf. You will be able to either save it to your computer, or print a clean copy.
